

Bark Stars of N Bedford

Sunday June 26th 1842

These 24 hours begins moderate breezes from NW fair weather at 8 till a small squall from NW middle and last part strong gales from NW clear weather Bar 29.8 & 9

Lat 03-13 S Long 176-41-8 E

Monday June 27th 1842

Commences fresh breezes from NW to NW middle and latter part fine moderate breezes at 6 tacked to East at 2 till tacked to NW at 11 till saw Rocks Island bearing NW 25 Miles Bar 29.082

Lat 2-40 S Long 176-04-8 E

Tuesday June 28th 1842

these 24 hours light baffling winds from NE to SE with clear weather but small from the East between 4 and 5 till had 8 canoes from Rocks Island hauled off 12 miles to get to us as feared harmless but had nothing of consequence to tell Saw Bark Whaler at 3 till standing NW Bar 29.54

Lat 03-27 S Long 165-56-8 E

Wednesday June 29th 1842

these 24 hours begins light airs from East middle and latter part moderate breezes from ESE at 10 till saw Hope or Shields Island bearing NW by E 12 Miles East land here 8 Miles 15 Miles Bar 29.082

in Pacific Ocean Whaling

Thursday June 30th 1842

These 24 hours moderate breezes from SE latter part NW to NE fair weather got clear of a lot of canoes that came off from Hope Island at 2 till 11 by running off from the Island NW stage got in a row with the state and refused duty but here in 2 rows Bar 29.9

Lat 1-51 S Long 176-32 E

Friday July 1st 1842

Commences with moderate breezes and fair weather fine NW to NW latter part of the night equally but part light breezes from NW to NW strong shortly current at 6 till Byrons Island bore NW 15 Miles but tacked to SE the rebel rig Bar 29.09 8 Miles NW 12 Miles

Lat 1-39 S Long 176-31 E

Saturday July 2nd 1842

Commences with a brisk breeze all night at NW but to ESE passed the Wind Ward of Byrons Island at 5 till had several canoes to come off the boat of 15 or 20 miles more than 40 started but having a good breeze kept out of their way middle and last part strong breezes from ESE

saw a ship to windward Bar 29.082

Lat 00-37 S Long 177-44 E
