

Bank Stars of New Bedford in

Sunday July 3th 1842

Commences with strong breezes from ESE under double reefs jib and spanker in last rather more moderate set jib. Spanker on different tacks Bar 29-08

Lat 00-02 N Long 176-48 E

Monday July 4th 1842

Commences with fresh breezes middle and last part light with fair weather had a squall and storm at 12 M Bar 29-09

Lat 00-28 N Long 176-18 E

Tuesday July 5th 1842

There 24 hours light breezes from ESE to SE fair weather set Stage out of ports as he promised to return to duty Bar 29-09

Lat 00-21 N Long 175-40 E

Wednesday July 6th 1842

Commences with light breezes ESE middle and last part fresh to Bar 29-09

Lat 00-49 S Long 174-50 E

Thursday July 7th 1842

There 24 hours fine breezes clear weather Wind ESE at 4 AM saw Sumner's Island bearing SSW headed to NE at 6 AM steered off SE ran down to NW end of Irons Isle passed to Windward of Sydney's Island

just discern it at 8 AM bearing W by S Bar 29-09

Lat 00-00 S Long 174-24 E 15 miles to go

Pacific Ocean Whaling at Sumner's Island

Friday July 8th 1842

There 24 hours fresh breezes from ESE fair weather passed on the east side Sydney's Island steered south run down by the NW end of the Island at 10 AM saw many canoes fishing all a pair of us Bar 29-09

Lat 10-14 S Long 173-54

Saturday July 9th 1842

There 24 hours fresh and unsteady breezes and fair weather from ESE to SE run down by the weather end of Simpson's Island at 5 AM had 4 or 5 canoes come off could not get clear of them until 12 AM and run off from the land passed the NW end of the Island at 9 AM ran down between Henderson and ^{Woodville} Islands in the passage at 12 AM Bar 29-08

Lat 10-10 N Long 173-09 E to far to the west

Sunday July 10th 1842

There 24 hours begins with a fresh breeze at 8 AM passed through the passage of Woodville and Henderson Island hauled by the wind to south at 10 AM tacked to North E middle wind light latter part fresh breezes and squally at 5 AM ran into a shoal of Spinn Whales after a squall and had been chased by between 30 and 40 canoes from Woodville Island commenced got 2 barrels and Whist boat got there a long ride at 10 AM had a heavy squall about the time at 12 AM Woodville Is. came ESE North point 18 miles S
