NNW thick and stormy middle moderate
made sail more wind hauled to NNE but
part fine breeze all sail set
Bar at 4 AM rising 29.6 at 8 29.07 at 12 AM 29.08
Lat Obs 27-20 N long 162-45 E Circ

Wednesday Sept 28th 1842
Commences with fresh breeze from NNE and
fair weather middle light and haphing
last part nearly a calm Bar rising 29.08
Lat Obs 27-16 N long 160-20 E Circ

Thursday Sept 29th 1842
these 24 hours light and variable air
and Calms most part Cloudy Bar up 30.07
Lat 27-26 N long 159-59 W Circ

Friday Sept 30th 1842
these 24 hours light haphing and variable
air and Calms Bar 30.04
Lat Obs 27-15 N long 159-36 W Circ

Saturday Oct 1st 1842
These 24 hours calm except some
light haphing and variable air last
part rainy Bar falling gradually over 29.08
Lat Obs 27-03 N long 159-24 W Circ

Pacific Ocean Whaling Abner's Bark

Sunday Oct 2nd 1842
Commences Calms heavy middle and latter
part light moderate breeze from West clear
steering sails all set Bar rising 29.07
Lat 26-24 N long 157-14 E Circ

Monday Oct 3rd 1842
these 24 hours moderate breeze from the
WNW fair weather all sail set Bar 29.07
Lat Obs 25-50 South long 154-55 W Circ

Tuesday Oct 4th 1842
these 24 hours begins light winds from
WNW last part from East to SNE
cloudy thick weather Bar 29.07
Lat Obs 24-43 N long 153-36 E Circ

Wednesday Oct 5th 1842
These 24 hours begins strong and unsteady
breeze from East cloudy at 4 AM heavy squalls
from NNE rain continues unsteady and squally
at 9 AM got a breeze from South latter the
rest of 24 hours last part clear Bar 29.07
Lat Obs 23-38 N long 152-55 E Circ

Thursday Oct 6th 1842
These 24 hours fresh breeze from East to
South fair weather at day light saw the
Island of Oahu bearing 111 15 Miles
Bar on 30.00
Lat Obs 21-24 N long 151-23 E Circ
Circ near 40 miles to far West
