Sunday Dec 18th 1842

These 24 hours baffling and unsteady
Winds with several squalls and storms
most part fair Winds NW to West Bar 29.07
Lat 29-21 Long 177-25 To W 1/2 NW

Monday Dec 19th 1842

these 24 hours begins fresh breezes from NW
Middle lat part light from South to NW
headed south until day light backed to West
at 12 Men Reckoner bore N 1/2 W Bar 29.08
Lat 29-48 Long 178-00 W End

Tuesday Dec 20th 1842

these 24 hours light baffling airs
and variable mostly from NW saw
Whales at 4 AM going quick to NW
battered but did not get near enough
to see them out boats Bar 29.08 to 9
Lat 29-09 Long 178-00 bearing W 1/2 NW

Wednesday Dec 21st 1842

these 24 hours light variable airs and
calms but part mostly cloudy Bar 29.08
1 Whaler Sunday Island bore NW
No Obs

Thursday Dec 22nd 1842

Commences with light airs and variable with
calms middle moderate breezes from NW latterly
fresh gales and squally with rain at 12 noon
Sunday Island bore South 18 miles but
saw a sail on to NW suppose it to be London

Friday Dec 23rd 1842

Commences with fresh gales from N & equally
strong steering S 1/2 W at 9 AM bore too near
bar at 12 AM Wind shifted to NW blew
a gale the rest 24 hours Bar 29.08 & 11 AM 29.09
Lat Obs 29-24 Long 179-30 West

Saturday Dec 24th 1842

Commences with a gale from NW to NW
bore two middle hauled to NW but bore
equally but more moderate rain under
double keels Bar 29.07
Lat 29-10 Long 179-42 East

Sunday and Christmas Dec 25th 1842

These 24 hours moderate and unsteady breezes
from N to South and over cast weather headed to
West Wind Bar 29.08
Lat Dec 29-33 Long 180-39 E

Monday Dec 26th 1842

These 24 hours begins with cloudy weather
breezes moderate latter light fair weather
Winds from NW saw a ship to NW
headed South Wind Bar 29.07
Lat 30-24 Long 176-15 E End

Tuesday Dec 27th 1842

These 24 hours light breezes from South to
East fair weather no moon Bar 30.00
Lat Obs 30-55 Long 175-12 E End

Wednesday Dec 28th 1842

These 24 hours light baffling Winds and fair
weather strong current to West Bar 29.09
Lat Obs 30-58 Long 174-00 E End
