Thursday Dec 29th 1842

Comences with light airs from N & middle calm. Lat part lat part light and variable from N & to NW strongest bar 29.09 day to 8 Mils Dr 31.14 by 193-50 & C.

Friday Dec 30th 1842

Comences moderate breezes and squally wind N & middle middle squally with heavy showers thunder lightning lat part squally some showers wind light from N & to NW spoke the bark Kilmear of London 13 Month out 600 Obbs Bar 29.08 Lat Dr 32-19 1 by 193-10 & C.

Saturday Dec 31st 1842

Comences with thick stormy weather some thunder light rain at 5 AM some tea under close reef Main top sail top sails wind varying middle and lat part fresh breezes fair weather wind from South to NW Bar 29.08 rising Lat Ob 32-15 1 by 193-12 & C.

Sunday 1st January 1st 1843

Comences with fresh breezes from NW fair weather lat part moderate from West headed to South and the lat Bar 29.06 Lat Ob 33-00 1 by 195-44 & C. Power off the coast

Monday Jan 2nd 1843

Comences moderate breezes and stormy wind NW to SW shifted to NW some tea at 12 Mils took in all top sail 5 AM split fore spencers bag under fore spencers top main stay sail at 6 AM took in West boat lat part strong gale NW Bar 29.06 Lat Dr 33-01 1 by 195-45 & C.

Pacific Ocean Whaling Abrownette Bark

Tuesday Jan 3rd 1843

Comences strong gale bad sea some tea under close reef Main top sail middle to wind NW lat part more moderate fair weather Bar comences 29.08 rising 13 AM 29.12 12 Mils 29.09 Lat 32-44 1 by 195-14 & C.

Wednesday Jan 4th 1843

Comences with fresh gales bad sea middle and latter part moderate breezes fair weather Wind from South to NW Bar 29.09 to 29 Lat 32-16 1 by 194-00 & C.

Thursday Jan 5th 1843

Comences with moderate breezes from the South fair weather middle and lat part very light breezes from NW headed to 13 & 12 Mils Bar 29.09 Lat Ob 32-30 1 by 195-52 & C.

Friday Jan 6th 1843

There 24 hours light softing airs with calm Bar on 30 Lat 32-36 1 by 194-05 & C.

Saturday Jan 7th 1843

Comences with calm at 12 Mils took a breeze from the West lat part bluffs very unsteady moderate Bar falling com 30 12 Mils 29.08 Lat Ob 33-05 1 by 194-15 & C.

Sunday Jan 8th 1843

Comences squally and unsteady wind from NW middle to lat part light and variable 25 Mils spoke the ship Maria Theresa of N B & Mount 200 Mils 50 spencers Bar down to 29.07 Lat 34-17 1 by 194-24 & C.
