Wednesday Jan 18<sup>th</sup> 1843

Commences with fresh gales fair weather  
by being middle and last strong gales  
increased weather & 12<sup>th</sup> till got our whale  
a long side began to cut a 2<sup>nd</sup> till got all  
in case bailed at 2<sup>nd</sup> till have two under  
M. Spencer stay sail Wind NE to E began  
to bail at 7 till on head Bar 29.08

Thursday Jan 19<sup>th</sup> 1843

There 24 hours begins with strong gales  
middle to some light Spencer Wind NE  
last part moderate Wind NE Bar 29.07  
finished bailing at 9 till filled 3<sup>rd</sup> till 10 till

Friday Jan 20<sup>th</sup> 1843

Commences with light winds and varying SW to  
NW breeze middle thick equally last part  
strong gales from NW to South at day light  
struck down about 10 till if bit we had one  
back Bar 29.07 began to bustle & till of 29.08

Saturday Jan 21<sup>st</sup> 1843

Commences with unsteady and variable and  
bustling Winds and fair weather middle  
latter part fresh gales from SE corner  
at storming down at day light

Sunday Jan 22<sup>nd</sup> 1843

Commences with fresh gales and increasing & 2 till took  
in jibe & 4 took in fore till sail finished storming down  
at 6 till got down 84 till all down but one breaker  
more ship to south have two under spinnaker close reef all till sail  
log the rest 24 hours Wind ESE Bar 29.08

Monday Jan 23<sup>rd</sup> 1843

Commences with strong gales from ENE cloudy  
middle and last part moderate and bailing  
from E to SE headed to South and till Bar 29.07

Tuesday Jan 24<sup>th</sup> 1843

Commences with light bailing Winds from SE  
to NW breeze & 5 till spoke the ship Manta  
of Hudson 18 Month out 400 till spinnaker 1100 till  
middle clear last part strong gale from NW

Bar 29.08 Lat 33-16 S Long 173-50 E

Wednesday Jan 25<sup>th</sup> 1843

Commences with strong gales from NW clear  
middle moderates last part moderate breeze  
and fair weather & sail in sight to the north

Thursday Jan 26<sup>th</sup> 1843

There 24 hours bailing and unsteady  
Winds from South and fair weather spoke  
Bar Kipliman Eng and So Hecla of Rochester  
600 till spinnaker 1100 till Bar 29.07
