Friday Jan 27th 1843

There 24 hours light air and variable with Calms 2 sail in sight Bar 30-01

Lat 32-40 S Long 175-22 E

Saturday January 28th 1843

There 24 hours light air from South to West fair weather current to NE Bar 30-02

Lat 32-04 S Long 175-11 E

Sunday January 29th 1843

Comences with light winds from South Middle from the E Moderate last part from so strong gales men 3/4 W had a much White Water difficult seeing raised 10 feet at 11 AM at 11.30 AM lowered but lost the view of them Bar 30-03 at 12 AM lat 29-09

Lat 33-South Long 174-50 E

Monday Jan 30th 1843

Comences with strong gales from East got the boats on board at 1 PM but too much Wind and sea to do any thing saw a Whale to Wind Ward at 3 PM from Mast head middle and part gale and clear Bar 30-02-03

Lat 32-50 S Long 173-57 E

Tuesday Jan 31st 1843

There 24 hours strong gales from East and fair weather headed to South spoke the Bark Hesper of Fairbairn 1700 1200 lbs of spermaceti Bar 30-01 to 30-01

Lat 34-02 S Long 173-54 E

# Pacifican Whaling & Brimble Book

Wednesday Feb 1st 1843

Comences with fresh gales from the East middle and last part moderate and hailing thick heavy weather Wind North to NE some light showers at 4 PM saw the South Cape New Zealand bearing NW and 3 Kings NW

at 12 AM a Whale bore South 15 Miles lat Bar 29-09 at 12 AM

No Obs

Thursday Feb 2nd 1843

Comences with weather Wind NE to South 4 hours rain at 5 PM broke away lat part strong gales from South to NW saw the last of day light bearing NW

headed to E Ward Bar begins 29-08 lat 12-09

Lat Obs 35-10 S Long 175-11 E

Friday Feb 3rd 1843

Comences with strong gales from NW clear weather middle moderate at 11 PM last part moderate

buzzes from E to NE heavy thick some light showers Bar 29-09 Lat 35-00 S Long 175-11 E

Saturday Feb 4th 1843

Comences with moderate and unsteady Winds from E to NE thick with showers of rain Bar rain at 7 PM cleared off middle and last part light winds from NE to South clear Bar 30-01 current to E

Lat 34-20 S Long 174-58 E

Sunday Feb 5th 1843

Comences with light air from NE clear middle below at 4 PM lowered for Black Duck got 4 of them last part fine moderate breeze from NE clear Bar 30-03

Lat Obs 34-19 S Long 174-58 E
