Comences with moderate and breezy weather wind from North at 6 PM shifted to South had it variable from S to South fair weather the next 24 hours at 6 AM saw a Whale chased him the next day Bar rose up to 30 continued next of No but nor log about 33.1 log 160.4

Friday Feb 17th 1843

Comences with unsteady breezes and fair weather middle and last part fresh gales and squally with some rain at a boat 3 PM got on to the Whale with main boat got the line fast carried the boat under but him never saw him after he went down wind South Easterly Bar up to 30 No Obs

Saturday Feb 18th 1843

There 24 hours fresh and unsteady winds from the NE and fair weather run to the North the last part Bar 30-

There 24 hours moderate breezes from ENE and fair weather run NW and NW had to with and night Bar 30-01

Wednesday Feb 22nd 1843

There 24 hours unsteady winds from ENE and the most part quite moderate steered to NW a powerful strong Current Bar 30
 Lat Obs 34-32.1 log 161-53 & &

Thursday Feb 23th 1843

There 24 hours begins with moderate and unsteady winds from the ENE fair weather middle to last part fresh gales from ENE squally bar falling from 30 to 29-08
 Lat Obs 34-50.1 log 160-52 &

Friday Feb 24th 1843

Comences strong gales squally at 2 PM bar too blew a gale from E to NE the rest of the 24 hours took in main boat bar falling to 29-05
 No Obs Lat 34-20.1 log 160-30

Saturday Feb 25th 1843

Comences with a heavy & gale and a high sea wind at 4 PM shifted to NW were shift to NW middle from NW to North wind unsteady sea had lost at 6 AM at fore sail at 9 AM took in fore sail at 11 AM sail lay under 2 spencers & still pitched off the main belaying look it in as it was so rugged to get any thing on the NW to NW Bar Com 29-05 at 5 PM 29-03 within 10 8 AM 29-04 Bar Lat a boat 34-20 log 161-50 about
