

Bark Mars of New Bedford in

Sunday Feb 26th 1843

Comences strong gales squally stormy here too
under Spencer's Wind NE at 4 PM Wind shifted to NW
more ship to NE the next 24 hours NW to NNW clear
middle moderates last part fine breezes clear
Bar begins at 29.04 at 4 PM & rises 12th at 29.04
Lat 34-08 N Long 161-35 E Crd

Monday Feb 27th 1843

There 24 hours begins with fresh breezes
and fair weather middle blowing strong
last part unsteady and thick more part stormy
Wind North Bar on about 29.08
At 06

Tuesday Feb 28th 1843

There 24 hours begins fresh breeze from
North thick cloudy at 4 PM shifted to NW
middle begins light breeze last part calm
Lat 33-55 N Long 161-25 E Bar 29.08 rising 30.00 at 12th

Wednesday March 1st 1844

Comences with a calm at 4 PM got a breeze from
the NW middle and last part moderate breezes
from SW clear weather passed a ship and hark
me to North and the other to New standing
to NE Bar rising gradually from 30 to 30.04 at 12th
Lat 33-10 N Long 160-51 E Crd

Thursday March 2nd 1843

There 24 hours most part variable and
unsteady Winds and fair weather first part
S part Middle NE last part East Bar 30.04
Lat 31-58 N Long 161-14 E Crd

Friday March 3rd 1843

There 24 hours unsteady breezes and fair weather third
a boat sent on different tracks held over on Bar 30.00
Lat 06 31-50 N Long 161-13

Saturday March 4th 1843

There 24 hours moderate and unsteady breezes and
clear weather Wind from the East on different track
current to NW Bar 29.04
Lat 31-57 N Long 161-12

Sunday March 5th 1843

There 24 hours begins moderate breezes and fair
last part fresh & cloudy from E to NE Bar 29.04 down to 8
Lat 31-33 N Long 161-22 E

Monday March 6th 1844

Comences with strong gales and gradually increasing
ends with a gale here to North breezes E & NE ends NE
Lat 30-53 N Long 161-50 E Bar falling from 29.08 to 29.06

Tuesday March 7th 1843

Comences with a gale of Wind from NE to NE
Middle begins to moderate last part strong breezes
and clear under double reef Bar rising 29.06 to 29.08
Lat 30-45 N Long 161-50 E Crd

Wednesday March 8th 1843

Comences strong breezes from NE Cloudy middle
middle and last part more moderate and
battering Wind E & NE Bar from 29.06 to 08
Lat 29-25 N Long 163-42
