Thursday March 9th 1843

These 24 hours winds very boisterous and unsteady with some squalls ranging from East to South Bar 29.08 to 9th
Lat 29.38 Long 163.00 E. Gro

Friday March 10th 1843

These 24 hours unsteady and boisterous winds and the most part cloudy Wind from ENE to SSE Bar 29.08 No Obs

Saturday March 11th 1843

These 24 hours moderate breezes from ENE to SE fair weather and the most part cloudy Bar 30.00
Lat Obs 29.08 Long 163.30 E. Gro

Sunday March 12th 1843

These 24 hours moderate breezes and fair weather Wind from ENE to SSE Bar 30
Lat 29.41 Long 163.20 E. Gro

Monday March 13th 1843

Commences with fresh gales from SSE to SE fair weather but part strong gales from SSE headed to South from 12.00 Bar 30.00 King 20.00
Lat 29.50 Long 163.41 E. Gro

Tuesday March 14th 1843

Commences with strong breezes from the East middle moderate but part light and clear headed to South Bar ranged 30 up to 30.00
Lat Obs 30.46 Long 163.19 E

Wednesday March 15th 1843

These 24 hours begins with moderate breezes from the East clear weather middle light and boisterous from the North with calm Bar 30.00 falling 12.00 to 30.00
Lat 31.17 Long 163.48 E. Gro

Thursday March 16th 1843

Commences light boisterous winds from North fair weather with some calm middle light but part thick and cloudy at 9 AM began to rain at 10.00 blew fresh squally from ENE to E have too under single reef top lay the rest of day No Obs Bar on a bar 30.00 the 24th

Friday March 17th 1843

Commences with thick squally and raining weather have too but not blowing hard middle heavy rain blowing strong at day light a heavy gale at 9 AM split fore top mast stay sail took in all spencer lay under fore reef all top sail for spencer at 6 AM were ship to North the Wind from ENE to SE the Bar has been on a bar 30 the 24 hours and has given no indication of bad weather No Obs

Saturday March 18th 1843

These 24 hours strong and unsteady winds from NE to East and but little rain at 11 AM set fore sail fore reef fore top sail
Lat Obs 31.50 Long 163.50 Bar 29.00 to 30

Sunday March 19th 1843

Commences strong gales have too middle and but part more moderate and fair weather headed to south but no winds from NE to East Bar 29.00
Lat Obs 32.16 Long 163.30 E. Gro
