There 24 hours fresh breezes from NE to E
headed to NE Bar 29-82 & 9

Lat Obs 33-10 S Long 163-39 E Cere

Tuesday March 21st 1843

there 24 hours moderate and unsteady
breezes from NE to ESE and fair weather
at day light while making sail &
Fredrick O Sonnel attacked the Cooper and
a bused the Mate called him aft to inquire
what he meant by such conduct he said
he would strike any man on board went to
take hold of him and then he struck me
and ran forward corner him self with
a mincing knife and a sheath knife said
he would kill the first man that touched
shot the hatchets and smoked him out and
put him in rooms Royal Goodenow and
John Wright said they would do no more duty
put them in rooms Bar a bout 30 the 24 hours

Wednesday March 22nd 1843

There 24 hours moderate and unsteady
breezes and fair weather Wind NE to ESE

Lat 34-31 S Long 165-55 Bar 30 to 30-01

Thursday March 23th 1843

there 24 hours moderate breezes from NE to SE
at 7 AM tacked to North let Wright out of room
as he promised to behave better Bar 30 to 30-01

Lat Obs 35-00 S Long 167 E Cere

Friday March 24th 1843

there 24 hours moderate breezes and fair weather
all sail set Wind from NE to E got headed to NE
the 24 hours Bar 30-00 & 2

Lat Obs 33-30 S Long 176-50 E Cere Lat 33-15

Saturday March 25th 1843

Commenced with fresh gales and fair weather middle
and latter part strong breezes squally sea bed & 7 AM
saw a ship to NE Wind NE to East Bar 30-01 & 2

Lat Obs 32-24 S Long 167-48 E Cere

Sunday March 26th 1843

Commenced with strong breezes from NE by the
sea middle and latter part light air
and calm Bar 30-01 down to 30

Lat Obs 33-01 S Long 168-27 E Long 168-50

Monday March 27th 1843

Commenced with light winds from the middle
middle varying to the West light with calm
& 10 AM breezes up with heavy squalling & times

Lat Obs 33-17 S Long 169-15 E Bar 30-

Tuesday March 28th 1843

There 24 hours unsteady breezes from the
North and squally under short sail during
the night saw a boat steering E got Bar 30

Lat 33-39 S Long 170-45 E Cere
