Friday June 23<sup>th</sup> 1843

These 24 hours Moderate and variable breezes and fair weather have been during the night at day light kept off West Wind from East to NE Bar 29.91

Saturday June 24<sup>th</sup> 1843

These 24 hours strong trades from NE at 1 PM saw Palmerston Island bearing West ran down near it hauled out to the South at 1 PM tacked to NE at 4 ran in near the land ran down to the middle Isle on the west side the reef passed the passage and 3 men settled there with their families got off a boat load of Coconut and 2 boys in 2 boats

Sunday June 25<sup>th</sup> 1843

Comenced strong trades and fair weather got off 4 boat loads of coconuts and meat with several boys got the last off of don't took a squall with a heavy shower ran off NW to get clear of the Island hauled too at 8 PM to wait tacked in at 3 got in at 8 AM got off 4 loads of coconuts and boys Wood middle and last part fresh trades and fair weather

Monday June 26<sup>th</sup> 1843

Comenced with fresh trades and clear got off 4 boat loads of coconuts at 8 PM kept off from Palmerston Island NW middle and last part moderate breezes and clear Bar 29-08.5

Lat 16-57 N Long 164-40 West

Tuesday June 27<sup>th</sup> 1843

These 24 hours moderate breezes from East and fair weather all hands employed sail making Bar 29.07  
Lat 16-13 N Long 166-10 West

Wednesday June 28<sup>th</sup> 1843

These 24 hours light winds from the SE and clear weather all hands employed repairing sails  
Lat 15-19 N Long 167-30 W Gro Bar 29.07.30

Thursday June 29<sup>th</sup> 1843

These 24 hours light air and clear from the East all hands employed sitting at rigging  
Lat 14-53 N Long 168-09 West Bar 29-08.5

Friday June 30<sup>th</sup> 1843

These 24 hours moderate breezes and clear from the East at 5 PM saw Koroake Island bearing NW hauled up passed to the North of it at 10 AM kept off to the West at day light saw Tromakulorah Island on of the Navigator ran down the rest of the day with light breeze at 12 noon a boat 30 miles distant bearing NE till Bar 29.07
