

Bark Mars of New Bedford in

Monday August 7th 1843

Comenced with strong breezes from East
headed to West at 4 PM tacked in on the North
side of Savy at 8 tacked to West tacked in
at 3 PM at 9 AM tacked close in on North side
the Island and the weather more moderate
so as to set only a reef to sail Bar 29.50-30
Lat Obs 13-23 Long 173-50

Tuesday August 8th 1843

these 24 hours Comenced with fresh gales
middle and East part blowing strong
carried close and double reef to sail with
out gill of in Spunkies kept in on the
NW side of Savy near the land the most
part Wind East to East Bar 29-09
at 10 AM 10 miles West of NW point Lat 13-23

Wednesday August 9th 1843

These 24 hours begins with strong gales
and clear middle and East part more
moderate at gill and spunkies at 8 AM
at day light set whole to sail with
a fresh gale made several tacks at 11 AM
tacked off from the land 7 miles but
Lat Obs 13-20 North in Savy 18 Bar 29.00-20

Thursday August 10th 1843

Comenced strong breezes under double reef
and reef gill and spunkies at middle
so East part rather more moderate
Winds from East to SSW clear the NW end
of Savy bar 29.00-30 Bar 29.09 to 30
Lat Obs 13-12 Long 172-53

the Pacific Ocean Whaling Abandoned

Friday August 11th 1843

These 24 hours begins with strong gales and fair
weather middle some showers haphing and unsteady
kept off for to run down the North side of Savy
East part haphing with calms at 11 AM the
West end of Savy bar 29.50 Lat Obs 13-20

Saturday August 12th 1843

these 24 hours haphing Winds and Calms
with some fresh puffs in different directions
occasioned by the high land to the South
run off for the West end of the Island of Savy
a very confused bad sea with Calms
Lat Obs 13-28 of the West end of Island S.W.

Sunday August 13th 1843

begins with heavy becalmed under Savy
high sea a breaker struck us in the stern but
did not fill the hold but took in a large quantity
of Water kept before the small took a breeze at 4 AM
blowing strong have had strong gales from 9 AM
to 11 the rest 24 hours under double and
reefs with out gill or Spunkies kept on the
southern tack the rest of 24 hours Bar 29-09
Lat 14-38 Long 174-09 bar about 30 miles to for West for
the most of the Navigate Islands
