Saturday Sept 16th 1843

Commenced with fresh breezes and fair weather under double and close reef top sails at 6 AM tacked to South at 6 AM tacked to the North last part Wind baffling with some heavy squalls Wind and rain Obs lat 16-13 South no log Bar on 30

Sunday Sept 17th 1843

There 24 hours fresh gales and fair weather under double and close reef heading to North days and south nights Lat Obs 16-01 1 log 173-34 Bro Bar on 30

Monday Sept 18th 1843

There 24 hours fair breezes from the East and fair weather headed South a nights and North Days then is a current for 3 or 4 days running to the West Bar on 30 Lat 15-57 1 log 173-28 Bro and by Sun 173-08 W

Tuesday Sept 19th 1843

There 24 hours fresh breezes and fair weather Winds from East to ENE headed North days south nights strong current to the West Bar 29 09 Lat Obs 15-47 1 log 173-20 W

Wednesday Sept 20th 1843

There 24 hours moderate breezes from the East and fair weather at 6 AM tacked to South continued on the southern tack the next 24 hours Lat 16-12 1 log 173

Thursday Sept 21st 1843

There 24 hours moderate breezes from NE to East fair weather saw a Whale at 12 and 10 min 1 PM lowered and chased until 5 PM could not get near him perceived the boat under water started off quick to Wind Ward Bar on 30

Lat Obs 16-08 South 1 log 173-00 Bro

Friday Sept 22nd 1843

There 24 hours moderate breezes from NE to ENE and fair weather tacked to North at 6 AM kept on the Northern tack the rest of the day Bar 30 Lat Obs 15-32 1 log 172-34 W Bro

Saturday Sept 23rd 1843

There 24 hours moderate breezes from the East and fair weather no Whales Bar on 30 Lat Obs 15-25 1 log 172-29 W

Sunday Sept 24th 1843

Commenced with light Winds from the East middle to Winds at 1 PM to 1 PM 6 PM tacked to the South last part equally fresh breezes from NE Lat 15-50 1 log 172-59 W Bar 30 to 29-09

Monday Sept 25th 1843

There 24 hours light baffling air and rainy with some squalls Winds from East to south strong current to West have made a boat 30 miles to the East of the Courses and 6 miles to the West of Bro Bar 29-09 Lat Obs 15-42 1 log 173-05 W Bar
