There 24 hours light breeze from the South and East clear weather Bar 30.6-29.09
Lat 15-05 N Long 172-05 W Cro

Wednesday Sept 27th 1843

There 24 hours very light air from S 18-05
Clear at 6 AM tacked to South latitude bearing
N 7/8 E headed to south the rest of the 24 hours
Lat Obs 15-20 N Long 172-15 W Bar 29.07-30

Thursday Sept 28th 1843

There 24 hours some light air from NE but the most part Calms
Lat 15-29 N Long 172-09 Cro L 171-51

Friday Sept 29th 1843

Commences with a calm middle and
last part light breezes from S 8 to 18
at 6 AM tacked to South strong NW current
Lat Obs 15-27 N Long 172-30 Cro

Saturday Sept 30th 1843

There 24 hours moderate and light breezes
from S 18 to 18 headed 8 hours to S and the
rest to South Lat 15-58 N Long 172-30 W Cro

Sunday Oct 1st 1843

Commences with light breezes from the N and
fair weather middle unsteady and baffling
headed to the East 5 hours last part strong
breezes and a confused bad sea from the South
Lat Obs 15-40 N Long 172-40 W Cro Bar on 30

Monday Oct 2nd 1843

Commences with light fresh gales from S 8 headed to
the South middle and last part moderate from 11-05
current to the NW Bar on 30
Lat Obs 17-52 N Long 173-10 W Cro

Tuesday Oct 3rd 1843

There 24 hours a fresh whole sail breeze from S 11
to S 8 fair weather under short sail during the night
Lat Obs 19-19 N Long 173-58 W Cro Bar on 30

Wednesday Oct 4th 1843

There 24 hours strong breezes from S 11 fair
weather at 6 AM double and closed, reefed top sail
tacked to North at 12 AM tacked to South at day light
steered by 8/8 compass Bar on 30
Lat Obs 20-31 N Long 174-00 W Cro

Thursday Oct 5th 1843

Commences with strong breezes from S 11
middle to last part thick and strong
from North to S 11 unsteady and baffling
have too at 6 AM under fore sail all top sail
to S 8 at 8 AM have too under topsails and
all top sail No O to a head 24 by 173-40

Friday Oct 6th 1843

Commences with thick strong weather Wind
at North middle moderate no rain heavy
last part fair with passing clouds and
very unsteady Winds from S 11
at 6 AM more ship to West made sail
current to S Bar 29-08 at 9
Lat Obs 22-01 Long 173-45 Cro
