Commenced with a calm at 8 AM took a light breeze from the North steered off under fore sail double reef all top sail high small from NW at 8 AM saw Whales going quick to the West loped two cut them off with the boats the waist boat got among but them did not faster or try to as the boat leaders could not make the boat steerer see him I am worn out with such work but must persevere and try to better it next time Lat about 24-20 N long 173-04 Bar 29.09

Monday Oct 16th 1843

There 24 hours hailing and very unsteady Winds from NW to NE about 5 hours calm from 8 AM to 1 PM at 2 PM commenced the boats and chased the Whales until sunset could not get on sea has been rough from the West Bar vis 29.07.8

Tuesday Oct 17th 1843

There 24 hours hailing and variable Winds and Calms had a heavy shower from the NW fore part of the the rest fair weather

There 24 hours moderate and variable Winds from NE to SE current to NE Bar 30

Thursday Oct 19th 1843

Commenced with moderate breeze from NE fair weather middle and part light breeze from W to NW rainy steered NW during the day off time too I night Bar vis 29.09.8

Friday Oct 20th 1843

Commenced with light hailing Winds from the NW and cloudy with some moderate rain lat part Wind light from South to NW clear back to NE at 6 AM Bar vis 29.10.8
Lat 24-45 N long 173-58 W Bar vis 29.10.8

Saturday Oct 21st 1843

Commenced with light hailing air from the NW middle varying to the NE to W with but very little wind lat part a moderate and steady breeze from NE had small from the NE Bar vis 29.09.8
Lat 25-18 N long 174-42 W Bar vis 29.09.8

Sunday Oct 22nd 1843

Commenced with moderate and unsteady Winds from NE fair weather middle stormy and sandy unsteady and hailing lat part from the NW equally rainy No Obs Bar vis 29.08.8

Monday Oct 23rd 1843

Commenced with moderate breeze from the NW cloudy hailing middle equally from the NW lat part strong breeze from NW clear under double and fore reefs jib all sail in
Obs Lat 27-30 N long 175-00 Bar vis 29.09.8
