

Bark Mars of New Bedford in

Friday May 10th 1844

These 24 hours moderate and unsteady breezes from the NE and cloudy with some light showers of rain steered to the NE & 8 AM Lord Flouces Island bore NW Bar on 30-01. Not yet to be depended on a boat 30-00

Saturday May 11th 1844

These 24 hours unsteady winds and cloudy the most part with some light showers the greater part fair Bar 30-01. Wind from NE to South

Let Obs 30-01 by 160-30 Bar

Sunday May 12th 1844

Comences with moderate breezes and fair weather ranging from East to NE middle so let squally and unsteady with showers Let 29-00 by 161-19.1 Bar 30-01.2 at 12.30

Monday May 13th 1844

These 24 hours fresh and unsteady Winds and fair weather Wind from the NE run off NW by Compass a boat ran in before sundown saw them what run off and anchored but one boat after sundown it being the first time they came up got one too but went down kept to the NW all night none in the morning but saw no more of them Bar 30-01.2

Let Obs 28-26.1 by 161-21.1 Bar

Tuesday May 14th 1844

These 24 hours very unsteady Wind some squalls fresh and light Winds from NE to NW 30-01

one of our new men Dexter Davis by name got into a row with the boatsteward that had charge of the watch could not satisfy him my self until I gave him one box and kept him in the row in houses. At night he then concluded not to order to fly him a gain and go to his duty

Let 27-27.1 by 162-01.8

Wednesday May 15th 1844

Comences with moderate breezes from NE to NW last part light airs from NE with calms. Let 26-54.1 by 161-15.1 Bar 30-01

Thursday May 16th 1844

These 24 hours light airs from NE with calms the most part calms Bar on 30

Let Obs 26-42.1 by 161-34.6 Bar

Friday May 17th 1844

nearly the whole of these 24 hours Calm Bar 30-01.2 Let 26-44.1 by 161-35.6 Bar

Saturday May 18th 1844

These 24 hours Calm except some light airs from NE Bar 30-00 Let Obs 26-40.1 by 161-34.6 Bar

Sunday May 19th 1844

These 24 hours Comences light + airs middle of day and last part squally with showers Wind East to NE. No Obs - but same sick for the 48 hours past with a high fever it brings of serious thoughts that health is lost
