Sunday June 30th 1844

Comences with moderate baffling winds from NW to  
NW thick rainy middle of day but strong  
wind from the NW strong under double reef  
made one 3 hour tack to West No Obs Bar 29.85

Monday July 1st 1844

There 24 hours light breezes from NW fair weather  
since 11 AM when it cleared of our cloud to drift  
Lat Obs 24-07 1 by 192-48 Bar 30.00  
cut out and put the cloths together for a top  
must stay sail

Tuesday July 2nd 1844

There 24 hours light winds from the south  
with calms & a swell from NW had steering  
way the 24 hours going from West to NW  
Lat Obs 23-53 1 by 192-59 8 Bar 30.02 at noon

Wednesday July 3rd 1844

There 24 hours begins with light breezes  
breezy middle and last part fine moderate  
breezes cloudy no Obs Bar 30.01

Thursday July 4th 1844

Comences with breezes from NW still thick squally  
wind backed to ~~SW~~ it is a heavy squall here two  
under close reef all top and fore spinnec. It is  
moderate last part squally rainy wind from NW  
Lat Obs 22-38 1 by 192-42 1/2 Bar 29.07

Friday July 5th 1844

Comences baffling winds from the North rain and calms  
middle and last part moderate breezes from South to NW  
Lat Obs 21-52 1 by 192-34 Bar 29.00

Saturday July 6th 1844

There 24 hours westerly winds from South to NW some show  
fanned and bent a new fore top mast stay sail to  
Lat Obs 20-40 1 by 191-30 1/2 Bar 29.00

Sunday July 7th 1844

There 24 hours fresh gales from South and fair weather  
ran during the night under reefed sails & day light  
made ~~to~~ Savage Island leaving NW of our to the  
east of it & 12 miles here NW of it steered NW was that  
15 miles but it made Obs Lat 19-15 1 by 190-23 1/2  
the Chronometer to far to the East by this hour 18 miles

Monday July 8th 1844

Comences with fresh breezes from South middle light  
and baffling & heat last part high air from NW  
to NE Lat Obs 18-40 1 by 190-28 Bar 30.00

Tuesday July 9th 1844

There 24 hours light winds from NE to East with  
calms Lat Obs 17-05 1 by 190-32 Bar 30.00

Wednesday July 10th 1844

There 24 begins moderate breezes from NE middle  
and last part high at back sailmaking  
Lat Obs 15-58 1 by 190-26 1/2 Bar 30.00

Thursday July 11th 1844

There 24 hours light breezes from East to NW  
fair weather at day light made Tottleback hill  
bearing NW NW of it 12 miles by Bone NW NW of it  
Toomabook here NW of it  
Lat Obs 14-40 1 by 190-16 1/2 Bar 30.00
