

Bark Mass of New Bedford in

Saturday August 24th 1844

There 24 hours unsteady breezes and fair weather ran down toward Kaiti Tala at 6 PM but too 8 miles to Windward at day light run off to the West of it. It is but sent a boat on shore landing not good no inhabitants got a few Coconuts headed off by the Wind at 9 AM Wind (P) 4 to 10 by 1 Lat Obs 18-54 1 by 174-52

Sunday August 25th 1844

There 24 hours begins fresh gales from N. middle and last part moderate made several turns to the West off Tapaoua Lat Obs 19-39 1 by 175-17 W. C. 1

Monday August 26th 1844

There 24 hours moderate and unsteady breeze from N. to South headed the most of the time to the South near 3 Miles to the West Lat Obs 20-23 1 by 175-52 West C. 1

Tuesday August 27th 1844

There 24 hours light airs from North to N. with Calms at 12 Men Tapaoua have 5-18 15 miles but Lat Obs 21-02 1 by 175-24 C. 1

Wednesday August 28th 1844

There 24 hours begins with light breezes from NW run round to the West of Tapaoua have too 1 PM and heavy North last part from NW to NW at 12 Men Tapaoua have N by E Wind very light Lat Obs 21-24 1 by 175-02 C. 1

Thursday August 29th 1844

There 24 hours light haphing and variable Winds at 9 AM wind hauled to East ran down the South West side of Cook went on shore at dark got 2 goats some fruit in the morning went on shore got off 4 boat loads of bags and gums the gums is good but both bags and gums are dear traded 680 galls of Point for what we got

Friday August 30th 1844

There 24 hours moderate breezes from N. to East at 5 PM got the things on board headed off to the East 18 hours too during the night all sail off Cook Lat Obs 21-54 1 by 174-34 W. C. 1

Saturday August 31st 1844

Comes with moderate and unsteady Winds from N. to East to N. middle equally with heavy showers of rain Wind N. W. last part light haphing Winds from the West with fair weather Lat Obs 21-59 1 by 174-00 1

Sunday Sept 1st 1844

There 24 hours begins with light airs from the NW much hazy weather middle and last part Calm Obs in Lat 21-48 1 by 1

Monday Sept 2nd 1844

There 24 hours light haphing airs from East to South with Calms some most showers of rain headed to the East Lat Obs 21-14 1 by 173-20 C. 1
