The first part strong wind from the SE. Corn 80 by 6. With and later part much the same. The watch employed in ship's duty

Monday July 2nd

The first part light wind from the SE. Corn 80 by 6. With and later part strong ship under double reef topsails were used By Alt

Lat by Alt 40.48 Long 69.59.45

Tuesday July 3rd

The first part light wind and calm sea thick With and later part much the same ship under 80 by 6

Lat by Alt 40.23 Long by Alt 69.16

Wednesday July 4th

The first part moderate breeze and calm sea Corn 80 by 6. With part squally with thunder later part clear all hands employed in ship's duty By Alt

Thursday July 5th

The first part light wind and calm all sail set Corn 80 by 6. With and later part much the same four ships in sight the watch employed in ship's duty By Alt

Friday July 6th

The first part fine all sail set Corn 80 by 6 at 5 PM part the reach of a vessel With and later part much the same weather the watch employed in ship's duty

The first part fine wind from the West all sail set With and later part much the same the watch employed in ship's duty Corn 80 by 6 By Alt

The first part strong wind from the SE. Corn 80 by 6. With and later part much the same the watch employed in ship's duty By Alt

Lat by Alt 38.19 Long 68.00.15

Tuesday July 10th

The first part moderate breeze from the East all sail set With and later part strong wind. Corn 80 by 6 all hands employed in ship's duty

Lat by Alt 38.23 Long 68.50.15

Wednesday July 11th

The first part strong wind from the East all sail set With and later part much the same saw a bark ship steering East by Alt

Lat by Alt 39.10 Long 68.23.15

Thursday July 12th

The first part strong wind from the SE. Corn 80 by 6. With and later part much the same all hands employed in ship's duty By Alt

Friday July 13th

The first part strong wind from the West Corn 80 by 6 at 7 PM double reef the topsails With and later part much the same were used By Alt
