

9 Remarks on Board Ship Weather & Sea
Thursday July 26th 1858

The first part of the day employed in copying oil
Mills and later part much the same saw
nothing new end.

Friday July 27th

The first part weather fine employed in copying
at 4 PM finished Mills and later part much
the same weather at 6 AM ship off the harbor
of Fayal at 8 went on shore with one boat
for coconuts and to send the oil home seaward.

Saturday July 28th

The first part fine all hands employed in
saltpetre the oil on shore and receiving
coconuts on board at 4 PM finished and put
to sea Mills and later part much the same
at 6 AM steamed S by West saw one Booby Pigeon in sea.

Sunday July 29th

The first part fine breeze from the West
Coast S by W Mills and later part much
the same weather saw end.

Monday July 30th

The first part light wind from the NW
Coast S by W all sail set all hands employed
in stowing every redoubtable Mills and
later part much the same saw end.

Tuesday July 31th

The first part light wind and pleasant all
sail set Coast S by W Mills and later
part much the same the watch employed
in ship's duty so end.

Lat by Ch. 35.08 Long 27.28

Remarks on Board Ship Weather & Sea
Wednesday August 1st 1858

The first part light wind from the SE
all sail set lay out West saw nothing
at 4 AM took ship lay up S by W Mills and
later part much the same weather so end.

Thursday August 2nd

The first part light wind and calm Coast
S by W Mills and later part much the same
the watch employed in ship's duty by Ch.

Lat by Ch. 34.42 Long 26.23.45

Friday August 3rd

The first part light wind and calm all
sail set lay up S by W Mills and later part
much the same saw end.

Lat by Ch. 34.26 Long 26.13.45

Saturday August 4th

The first part light wind and calm lay
lay up S by W all sail set saw nothing Mills
& later part much the same saw end.

Lat by Ch. 33.50 Long by Ch. 25.50

Sunday August 5th

The first part light wind from the NW
Coast S by W Mills and later part much
the same saw end then a breeze by Ch.

Lat by Ch. 33.12 Long 25.54.45

Monday August 6th

The first part fine wind from the SE
all sail set Coast S by W West Mills
and later part much the same at 11 AM
saw a ship. Main not seen.

Lat by Ch. 32.08 Long by 25.45

Tuesday August 7th

The first part strong wind from the SE
Coast S by W Mills and later part much
took in top gallant sails saw end.

Lat by Ch. 29.40 Long 25.34.30
