The first part moderate wind, and thick with rain and
vivid lightning and heavy thunder. With and later
part moderate with rain from S by E and wind from
the N.E. wither and foggy saw nothing

Saturday November 24th

The first part strong wind, and squally from the N.E.
lay up S by E with rain and vivid lightning and hard
thunder. With and later part wind and weather
much the same at 8 AM heavy squalls took in from
the N.W. top sails saw nothing wither thick. No. 04 this day

Sunday November 25th

The first part strong winds from N.E. wither thick with
heavy rain. With part much the same later part
moderate at 8 AM wither fine and clear all sail set
from S.E. saw nothing

Monday November 26th

The first part moderate wind from the N.E. all sail set
from S by E lay S by E N.E. & S.E. saw finewhale. With

The first part strong wind from the N.W. West all

Wednesday November 28th 1838

The first part strong wind from the N.W. West all
sail set. With and later part much the same

The first part strong wind from the N.W. West all
sail set. With part much the same later part
more strong took in from S by E sail wind from the
N.W. West

Friday November 30th

The first part strong wind from the N.W. West all
sail set. With and later part moderate wind from
the West all sail set saw plenty of birds

Saturday December 1st 1838

The first part wither fine with moderate wind from the
West all sail set from S.W. saw nothing. With and later
part pleasant with fine breezes from the West from S.E. & N.

Sunday December 2nd

The first part moderate wind from the N.W. West all
sail set from S.W. saw a number. With and later
part strong wind and clear wither nothing in sight

Monday December 3rd

The first part wither fine and pleasant all sail set
with moderate breezes from the N.W. West from N.E. by E
With and later part more fresh saw nothing
