Thursday April 18th 1839

The first part pleasant with calm at 2 PM finished
hurling Mist part moderate wind from the North
steering S West later part much the same
Even I by 11 all sail set saw nothing employed
in breaking out the betwixt the saw end.

Ch. Rat was 59% slow

Friday April 19th

The first part weather fine & pleasant steering South
saw plenty of fish & birds Mist part much the same
later part squally with thick weather saw nothing

Lat by Ant 31.20 Long by Ant 146.35 W
Ch. Rat was 59% slow

Saturday April 20th

The first part weather thick & rainy with moderate
breezes from the SW steering S W under double
reef topsails saw nothing Mist part fine
later part thick and squally saw end
with calm no obs this day By Ant 146.20

Lat by Ant 31.10 Long in
Ch. Rat was 59% slow

Sunday April 21st

The first part weather thick and squally with
rain and vivid lightning and heavy thunder
Mist part heavy gale later part more moderate
not able reef topsails at 4 AM under ship lay up
West & by 9 saw nothing weather thick & heavy

Lat by Ch. 31.55 Long in by Ant 146.00
Ch. Rat was 59% slow

Monday April 22nd

The first part weather thick & cloudy lay up
W by 12 part a squall lay up. W by 2
saw nothing Mist and later part fine employed
in stowing down saw nothing saw end by Ch.

Lat by Ch. 31.25 Long in 146.05
Ch. Rat was 59% slow

Tuesday April 23rd 1839

The first part weather fine with moderate wind employed in
stowing down at 4 PM finished Mist and later part
light wind and calm saw nothing saw end.

Lat by Ch. 30.58 Long by Ch. 146.49.30
Ch. Rat was 59% slow

Wednesday April 24th

The first part weather fine and pleasant with calm
breezes W by 12 no wind Mist and later part much
the same calm By Ch.

Lat by Ch. 30.59 Long 145.52.15
Ch. Rat was 59% slow

Thursday April 25th

The first part calm weather fine and pleasant
saw nothing Mist and later part much the same
all sail set bower W West nothing in sight

Lat by Ch. 30.54 Long by Ch. 146.06
Ch. Rat was 59% slow

Friday April 26th

The first part weather fine with moderate breezes from
the South all sail set saw nothing Mist part much
the same later part strong wind from the S by 9
AM kept off by West four ships in sight

Lat by Ch. 30.24 Long by Ant 146.30 W
Ch. Rat was 59% slow

Saturday April 27th

The first part strong wind from the S. bower North
at 4 PM spoke ship Emily Morgan W B Clark Master
200 Mts and later part strong gale and squally
at 12 part to saw a plenty of large Whales. One
boats struck one at 12 Men got him spearing thick
blue weather squally with rain and thick weather
the boats employed in tanning up the whale but
giving to the windward bower. No obs this day
