

Remarks On Board Ship Martha F. Haven.
Sunday April 28th 1839

The first part strong gale from the ESE with squalls of wind and rain the boats employed in turning up the Wharf at 3 PM weather very thick left the wharf ahead on the weather and pulled for the ship at 4 PM got on board Wharf then to the windward bearing Per Compas South Dist 2 miles weather very thick & rainy at dark spoke Ship E Morgan so had struck the rain time and lost 150 fathoms line and the wharf Mistle and later part bearing gale ship under double reefed topsails saw nothing of the wharf now end. *Chas*

Monday April 29th

The first part strong gale & squally with rain saw nothing of the wharf Mistle part more moderate with rain later part heavy gale from the S by E lay up ESE took in the foresail now end.

Tuesday April 30th

The first part heavy gale from the SE lay up S by E & ESE Mistle and later part much the rain ship under short sail now end. *By Chas*

Wednesday May the 1 1839

The first part ragged with squalls of rain and wind saw nothing Mistle and later part more moderate at 12 Midnight under ship & set the foresail lay up S by W at 6 AM set double reefed topsails & main sail saw forebooms now end. *By Chas*

Thursday May 2nd 1839
The first part strong wind from the East steering by E under double reefed topsails saw nothing Mistle and later part much the rain at 6 AM steamed North turned out the reefed M. & fore saw plenty of line now end. *By Chas*

Friday May the 3

The first part strong wind from the East over the saw plenty of line Mistle and later part much the rain at 10 AM saw a large wharf load all boats abaft but could not get fast saw end. *By Chas*

Saturday May the 4

The first part strong wind from the Eastward steering north at 4 PM steamed NW set a part & took in sail lay up North & at 8 PM set a main sail under ship lay up S by E later part much the rain weather at 6 PM main sail set & saw a shoal of several wharfs load all boats abaft could not fasten rain on board at 8 PM under wharfs load struck tower raised one ~~boat~~ *men* got him to the ship. *By Chas*

Sunday May the 5

The first part strong wind and ragged in the night in at 4 PM finished Mistle and later part much the rain at 6 AM main sail set & took a ship lay up North nothing in sight now end.
