

Remarks On Board Ship Martha Fair Haven

Thursday May 28th 1839

The first part fine weather wind from the S by E
one sail in sight Mistle and later part much
the rain at 6 PM over ship lay up East & ESE

Wednesday May 29th

The first part weather fine and pleasant all sail set
nothing in sight Mistle and later part much the rain
nothing in sight now and then 24 hours Chas

Lat by Ch. 25.12 Long by 174.09 West
Chas Rat 0' 7 1/2

Thursday May 30th

The first part weather fine and pleasant all sail set
lay up East & E by S Mistle and later part much
the rain at 6 PM one ship in sight rain not over

Lat by Ch. 25.05 Long by Ch. 172.58.30 W
Chas Rat 0' 8 1/2

Friday May 31st

The first weather fine and pleasant all sail set saw
nothing Mistle and later part much the rain
all sail set now and then nothing in sight by Chas

Lat by Ch. 25.18 Long 171.39 West
Chas Rat 1' 08 1/2

Saturday June 1st

The first part weather fine all sail set at 8 AM tacked
ship tow the WSW Mistle and later part strong wind
at 12 M saw a large whal boat all boats in chain

Sunday June 2nd

The first part weather fine employed in chasing the whal
at 2 PM struck the monster of the deep and in short
drew from him about 10 miles night but did not
quit fast even Mistle and later part very squally
with showers of rain one sail in sight rain not over

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Monday June 3rd 1839

The first part strong wind and squally one sail SE
in sight rain not over Mistle and later part heavy
gale with squalls of rain and wind nothing in sight

Tuesday June 4th

The first part strong gale and squally with rain at
8 PM saw blackfish rain then saw a boat could it or Sp. then
Mistle part more moderate later part strong wind
nothing in sight now and then

Wednesday June 5th

The first part strong wind and squally nothing in
right Mistle and later part much the rain
employed in repairing Main D. L. Sail now end 3 PM

Long by Dist at 9 AM 172.49.30 Chas Rat 0' 5 1/2

Thursday June 6th

The first part strong wind from the ENE nothing in
right Mistle and later part much the rain at 3 PM

Lat by Ch. 26.46 Long in by Ch. 172.38.45
Long by Dist at 9 AM 173.04 Long by Ch. the rain then 172.14
Chas Rat 0' 5 1/2

Friday June 7th

The first part strong wind from the ENE lay up E.
Mistle and later part strong gale and squally
saw fin backs now and then

Lat by Ch. 25.41 Long 171.50 W
Chas Rat 0' 7 1/2

Saturday June 8th

The first part strong wind from the SE nothing in sight
Mistle part heavy gale with rain later part more
moderate one sail in sight now and then

Lat by Ch. 25.00 Long by Ch. 171.55 W
Chas Rat 0' 7 1/2
