Monday July 1st 1839

The first part weather fine all sail set soon I went nothing
in sight at 5 PM took in sail made and later part
much the same at 6 AM made sail and steered WNW
saw blackfish and one finback

Tuesday July 2nd

The first part weather fine all sail set soon nothing made
and later part much the same nothing in sight

Lat by St. 23.08 Long by Chs 174.13.45
Chs Reel 0.1 15 1/2 sp

Wednesday July 3rd

The first part weather fine all sail set made and later
part squally with rain nothing in sight

Lat by St. 23.50 Long by St. 174.30 West
Chs Reel 0.1 15 1/2

Thursday July 4th day of our independence

The first part strong wind and squally with rain
made and later part much the same nothing in
sight saw one weather squally by Chs

Lat by St. 24.13 Long in 175.24
Chs Reel 0.1 15

Friday July 5th

The first part squally with rain saw finbacks made
and later part fine with all sail set saw finbacks

Lat by St. 24.26 Long by Chs 175.30 W
Long by Dist at 4 AM 176.30 60 miles to far West

Saturday July 6th

The first part squally with rain saw finbacks
made and later part much the same saw plenty of
finbacks

Lat by St. 24.58 Long by St. 175.10 W

Sunday July 7th 1839

The first part strong gale and squally with rain
made and later part much the same weather
wind from the SE by 4 PM East & by 4 PM Chs

Lat by St. 24.26 Long in 174.58
Chs Reel 0.1 15 1/2 slow

Monday July 8th

The first part strong gale from the SE by 4 PM
at 5 PM spent an evening barque on oil barrel from
the Bark Thabella of Fairhaven 17 June with 90 barrels
made and later part fine all sail set saw finbacks

Tuesday July 9th

The first part weather fine all sail set saw nothing made
and later part much the same weather nothing in sight

Lat by St. 24.31 Long by St. 174.40 West

Wednesday July 10th

The first part weather fine and pleasant with moderate breeze
and calm made the same later part
fine breeze from the WNW steering SE by E all sail set

Lat by St. 24.39 Long by Chs 174.56.15
Chs Reel 0.1 15 1/2

Thursday July 11th

The first part weather fine with strong breeze from the
West soon SE by E made part squally with rain
later part fine all sail set at 6 AM saw ships in
sight no more not near saw one by Chs

Lat by St. 25.24 Long 175.35.15
Chs Reel 0.1 15 1/2

Friday July 12th

The first part weather fine all sail set saw nothing made
and later part much the same weather all sail set nothing
in sight but finbacks saw one by Chs

Lat by St. 25.52 Long 176.48.30
Chs Reel 0.1 15 1/2 slow

And lanes Laffy 1/2 a second
