The first part weather fine all sail set saw nothing
Mist and later part much the same weather nothing in sight
Lat by Ch. 28.03 Long by Ch. 172.30 West
Chs Bar at 19th 40

Friday, July the 26th

The first part fine weather all sail set nothing in sight
Mist and later part some squally saw fin birds
Lat by Ch. 28.54 Long by Ch. 172.00
Chs Bar at 19th 40

Saturday July the 27th

The first part squally with rain saw fin birds
mist and later part fine all sail set saw nothing
Lat by Ch. 24.28 Long by Ch. 171.37
Chs Bar at 19th 40

Sunday July the 28th

The first part strong wind with some squalls saw nothing
Mist and later part more fine nothing in sight
Lat by Ch. 24.14 Long by Ch. 170.18 30
Chs Bar at 19th 40

Monday July the 29th

The first part strong wind from the South nothing in sight
Mist and later part much the same saw nothing
Lat by Ch. 24.14 Long by Ch. 168.41.30 West
Chs Bar at 19th 40

Tuesday July 30th

The first part strong wind from the South nothing in sight
Mist and later part more moderate with a heavy swell
at 9 AM saw a sail steering for him
Lat by Ch. 23.59 Long by Ch. 168.40 West
Chs Bar at 19th 40

Wednesday July 31st

The first part weather fine with a heavy swell on
Mist and later part at 2 PM spoke ship Rambler
from Newbet 100 miles 80 barrels Mist and
later part fine saw fin birds
Lat by Ch. 23.12 Long by Ch. 167.04 30
Chs Bar at 19th 40

Thursday August the 1st 1839

The first part strong wind and squally saw nothing in sight
Mist and later part strong gale ship under double reef
topails saw nothing saw birds

Lat by Ch. 22.52 Long by Ch. 168.20
Chs Bar at 19th 40

Friday August 2nd

The first part weather some thick with strong wind from the
NE nothing in sight Mist and later strong gale from
NE steering SW by W
Lat by Ch. 23.59 Long by Ch. 168.40
Chs Bar at 19th 40

Saturday August 3rd

The first part strong gale from the West steering SW by W
Mist part heavy gale from the W with sharp lightning
and very heavy rain and a tremendous sea on later part
more moderate set the four sail more ship lay up E by S
Lat by Ch. 24.12 Long by Ch. 168.35.45 W
Chs Bar at 19th 40

Sunday August the 4th

The first part strong gale from the the NW with a
low sea on mist and later part much the same
weather with squalls at 9 AM 168.31.15 West
Lat by Ch. 24.39 Long by Ch. 168.38
rain time by Ch. 168.31.15 Chs Bar at 19th 40
Saw a ship to far west on this side 60 miles

Monday August the 5th

The first part strong gale and squally shifted under short
sail lay up SW by S Mist and later part much the same
at 9 AM were ship lay up WNW saw nothing
Lat by Ch. 25.21 Long by Ch. 168.45
Chs Bar at 19th 40

Tuesday August the 6th

The first part more moderate lay up WNW by W saw nothing
Mist and later part fine later part pleasant
all sail set lay up NW West
Lat by Ch. 24.33 Long by Ch. 168.50
Chs Bar at 19th 40
