Wednesday August the 7th Ad 1839

The first part fair weather fine and pleasant all sail set
lay up West at 1 PM saw a shoal of sparrows which bore
all ~~the~~ boats about but very shy did not farther
whales homing WSW mile and later part much the
same weather bore WSW all sail set

Ch. Rat 0.1 21% slow

Thursday August the 8th

The first part weather fine and pleasant all sail set saw nothing
bore West by W mile and later part much the same
nothing in sight saw end at 10 AM when topmast
boom stay parted employed in repairing it

Friday August the 9th

The first part weather fine and pleasant all sail set with
morning breezes from the SSW bore W by W saw nothing
mile and later part much the same saw finbacks

Saturday August the 10th

The first part weather fine and pleasant with light wind
from the S bore W mile part much the same at 10 Mid
saw a whale near the ship supposed to be a sperm
whale haul'd the main yard aback for the night
later part fine all sail set nothing in sight

Sunday August the 11th

The first part weather fine and pleasant all sail set
bore W with light wind nothing in sight mile and
later part much the same weather

Monday August 12th Ad 1839

The first part weather fine and pleasant all sail set
saw one finback mile and later part much the same
nothing in sight bore W West Ch. Rat

Ch. Rat 0.1 22% slow

Tuesday August 13th

The first part weather fine and pleasant all sail set saw
nothing mile part much the same later part stormy
wind from the North saw nothing lay up W West

Lat by Ch. 24.59 Long by Ch. 171.00
Ch. Rat 0.1 23

Wednesday August 14th

The first part weather very thick with morning breezes from
the North lay up West nothing in sight mile and later
part much the same weather with rain

Lat by Ch. 25.07 Long by Ch. 172.00
Ch. Rat 0.1 23%

Thursday August 15th

The first part weather thick with morning breezes from
the S West lay up W by W mile and later part much
the same weather with light wind and calm

Lat by Ch. 25.31 Long by Ch. 172.55

Friday August 16th Ch. Rat 0.1 23%
The first part weather squally with light wind and variable
with some squalls of rain mile and later part more
set with rain and thick weather saw nothing

Lat by Ch. 25.20 Long by Ch. 171.45
Ch. Rat 0.1 23%

Saturday August 17th

The first part weather squally with rain and morning
breezes mile part more clear later part much the
same at 7 AM saw a ship saw then saw a large
whale load at 12 Mer struck and kill'd but the lumber
boat stove employed in getting the whale to the ship
