

Remarks On Board Ship Martha Fairbairn
Sunday August 18th 1859

The first part went out and then at 3 PM got the whail to the ship. and maid fast got dinner and at 4 PM began making at 6 PM head off at 7 hours 30 minutes body in Mill and later part wither fin at 9 AM finished cutting main sail and began heaving at 11 AM saw a large whail growing near to the W.C. land the boats about but could not get fast

Monday August 19th

The first part wither fin employed in heaving lay up S.E. Mill part again with light main later part main fin at 10 AM lay up. W.C. at 11 AM saw ship and steered south one sail in sight main not seen

Tuesday August 20th

The first part wither fin and pleasure employed in heaving nothing in sight. Mill and later part much the same. all sail set at 12 AM finished heaving
