

Remarks On Board Ship Martha Fair Haven
Thursday August 29th 1839

The first part however gale from the Eastward ship
under short sail while part much the same with heavy
rain and squalls with vivid lightning split the fore
topmast staysail and lost part of him while part
more moved ship under short sail lay up N by W
Lat by Ch. 25.18 Long by Chro 178.26.30
Chro Bar i 28 1/2

Friday August 30th

The first part however gale from the N E lay up E S E
to E by N while part heavy gale with vivid lightning
and heavy thunder later part much the same
Lat by Ch. 25.54 Long by Chro 178.33
Chro Bar i 26 1/2

Saturday August 31st

The first part strong gale from the N E and thick
middle much the same later part strong gale
from the N E ship under short sail lay up N N W
Lat by Ch. 26.33 Long by Chro 178.40
Chro Bar i 28 1/2

Sunday Sept 1st 1839
The first part heavy gale from the N E ship under short sail
lay up N N W while part vivid lightning and heavy
thunder with heavy rain later part moderate
and clear with calm at 8 AM got a distance from
the sun to Moon D and made the log 174.40 West
Long by Chro at 8 AM 178.48.15
Lat by Ch. 26.30 Chro Bar i 28 1/2

Monday Sept 2nd

The first part weather fine with moderate breezes & calm
all sail set nothing in sight but a heavy swell
while and later part calm imp. lay in repairing
sails row ends at 8 AM got a rest of Dist and
made the log 174.50
Long by Chro 178.27 West
Lat by Ch. 26.22 Chro Bar i 27 1/2

Tuesday September 3rd 1839

The first part moderate wind from E S E Calm N E
nothing in sight while and later part much the
same imp. lay in repairing main topsail beam N E
Lat by Ch. 25.53 Long by Chro 178.04.15

Wednesday Sept 4th

The first part moderate wind from E S E Calm N E
nothing in sight while and later part much the
same saw nothing all sail set Chro
Lat by Ch. 25.12 Long by 172.25.30
Chro Bar i 27 1/2

Thursday Sept 5th

The first part weather fine all sail set lay up N East
at 6 AM took in sail while and later part strong gale
nothing in sight lay up N East got at Dist at 10 AM
& made the log 174.55 West Long by Chro 178.04.15
Lat by Ch. 24.55 Long by Chro 172.16.30
Chro Bar i 27 1/2

Friday Sept 6th

The first part strong gale and squalls ship under
short sail topsail while and later part much the
same weather with a heavy sea on lay up N West
nothing in sight row ends Chro
Lat by Ch. 25.00 Long by 172.01

Saturday Sept 7th

The first part strong gale from the E S E lay up
N N W while and later part more moderate all sail
set saw fishbacks row ends Chro
Lat by Ch. 24.47 Long 172.34.30
Chro Bar i 28

Sunday Sept 8th

The first part fine weather with a heavy swell on saw
fishbacks while and later part much the same
row ends lay up E S E nothing in sight
Lat by Ch. 25.30 Long by Chro 172.29.30
Chro Bar i 28 1/2
