

Remarks On Board Ship Martha Fair Haven
Monday September 9th A.D. 1839

The first part strong wind from the E & E by S at 6 AM took in sail Mist and later strong wind and squally lay up W by W & W by W with rain at 12 Mer heavy rain and squally took in four of mizen top sails row end

Duesday Sept 10 Chro Rat 1.28 1/2 slow

The first part strong wind and squally part 12 Mer saw two large Whales land two boats at 8 PM struck the whale land the 3 boat at 9 PM hit the whale at 8 PM got him ~~to~~ the ship an man just weather thick & squally with strong wind Mist part much the rain later part fine at 5 began nothing at 12 Mer heavy rain & Boding in at 10 AM wind hauled to the S & West

Wednesday Sept 11th
The first part weather fine at 3 PM finished mending the Whales and set the works to quivering Mist and later moderate breeze and soon thick nothing in sight at 6 AM under ship lay up Sketh

Thursday Sept 12th
The first part weather thick and squally lay up S & E & East Mist part squally with strong wind later part thick nothing in sight saw one employed in bylling

The first part weather thick with strong wind at 2 PM finished bylling Mist part heavy rain later part moderate and soon thick lay up S & E & nothing in sight

Saturday September 14th A.D. 1839

The first part moderate and thick saw fin back Mist part squally later part moderate nothing in sight Calm

Sunday Sept 15th
The first part moderate and squally of rain Mist and later part much the rain with Calm saw one fin back

Monday Sept 16th
The first part weather thick with moderate breezes & Calm Mist and later part fine weather with calm nothing in sight employed in stowing down

Tuesday Sept 17th
The first part weather fine with strong wind from the S & S by E lay up S & E at 6 PM under ship lay up S by S & S by W Mist part much the rain later part strong gale at 10 AM double reef top sails nothing in sight

Long by Dist at 2 PM 172.50 Chro Rat 1.30

Wednesday Sept 18th
The first part weather fine nothing in sight Mist part much the rain later part strong wind at 10 AM double reef top sails

The first part heavy gale from the East lay up S & E at 5 PM took in the fore sail Mist and later much the rain weather nothing in sight
