Wednesday October 23rd the 1839

The first part weather fine at 4 PM got the raft on shore at 6 PM returned
on board with the raft weather squally got the raft in and dottle
except the topsails with heavy gales from the S.W. took in the
Four & Mizzen topsails With an later more fine stood in and
sent two boats on shore at 10 AM Calm boats returned with wood
giving 2 1/2 fathoms blue cloth per board and five of white

Thursday Oct 24th

The first part weather fine at 2 PM boats returned with wood
While and later part much the same weather employed in getting

Friday October 25th

The first part weather fine and pleasant at 8 PM finished
receiving the ship. While and later much the same at 7
AM I sent the watch on shore on liberty

The first part weather fine and pleasant at 6 PM
the Boat returned with the men While and later much
the same watch on shore at 3 PM returned

the land bearing South point

Tuesday Oct 29th

The first part weather fine with more west winds & Calm While
part much the same later part fine winds from the S.E.
Calm WNW nothing in sight at 8.30 got a dist from the
sun & Moon and read the Long 163.48 30 W
Long in at 3 PM 164.40³⁰ sun in by Ch. 163.58 W

Wednesday Oct 30th

The first part weather fine with brisk winds from the S.E. Calm
West While and later part much the same weather nothing
in sight at 11 AM steered a Calm W by South at 8 AM

The first part weather fine and pleasant all sail set Calm
S.W. While and later part much the same employed in

The first part weather fine all sail set with more west winds
& Calm While and later part much the same with Calm
