the first part heavy gale from the ENE lay up NW by W
at 3 PM took in fore & main topsails at 5 PM took reef

with strong wind from ENE by Ch. Ch.

the first part strong wind from the NE by E lay up NW by W
saw plenty of finbacks Mile and later part much
the rain at 11 AM saw a number of right whales bore
struck and killed one at 12 Mer got him to the ship
& cleared for 45th Crutney

the first part strong wind from the ENE lay up employed
in Crutney at 3 PM finished lost the head two ships

main sail with light wind from the North lay up
W by N & E Lat by Art 39.40 Long by Art 175.00

Sunday Dec the 8th Ch. Rat 5 45th show
the first part moderate and calm at 6 PM took a light
wind from the Westward one ship in sight saw another
Mist and later more the rain with one ship in sight
lay up W by E Coast NW by W by Ch.

Lat by Ch. 38.51 Long in 174.32
Monday Dec the 9th Ch. Rat 5 45th show
the first part moderate wind from the Westward Coast
NW West Mile and later part much the rain one
ship in sight main not seen Ch.

Lat by Ch. 37.02 Long by 174.25
Tuesday Dec the 10th Ch. Rat 5 45th show
the first part moderate wind and baffling Coast NW by W
Mist part strong wind from the North lay up NW by W
later part much the rain employed in repairing
Main topsail saw ends by Ch.

Wednesday Dec the 11th Ch. Rat 5 45th show
the first part strong wind from the North lay up NW by W
at 5 PM moderate with heavy rains Mile part much
the rain later part moderate and more a heavy
employed in repairing Main & fore sail Ch.

Thursday Dec the 12th Ch. Rat 5 45th show
the first part light wind and calm with rain
Mist and later part pleasant employed in
repairing Main sail Coast NW by W nothing in
sight Long by Ch. 175.44.30
