 Thursday Decem the 26th Chs Rat 5 49 1/2
 the first part weather thick with strong gale and
 roused lay up S by E & S by E saw greater plenty
 of birds Mistle and later much the rain quite
 plenty of birds in sight saw ends by Chs
 Lat by Ch. 31.13 Long in 178.00 15
 Friday Decem the 27th Chs Rat 5 50
 the first part strong gale from the E by S lay up
 South Mistle part more moderate later part
 strong gale from the S by E at 5 PM were ship
 lay up E by E nothing in sight
 Lat by Ch. 31.32 Long by Chs 178.07.30
 Saturday Decem the 28th Chs Rat 5 50 1/2 show
 the first part strong wind from the East employed
 in stowing down Mistle and later part much the rain
 employed in stowing down wind from the S by E lay up N by E
 Lat by Ch. 31.35 Long by act 178.14 W
 Sunday Decem the 29th Chs Rat 5 50 1/2 show
 the first part weather fine and pleasant saw plenty of fish
 Mistle and later part much the rain all sail set
 lay up N by E wind E by E at 2 PM

 Long by three sets of Distances from the sun and Moon

 the rain lay up N by E at 10 AM stowed N by E at 2 PM

 Long by Dist 4 30 PM 177.38 by Chs rain time 177.18
 Tuesday Decem the 31st Chs Rat 5 50 1/2
 the first part weather fine and pleasant all sail set
 stowing North at 4 PM stowed N by W Mistle and
 later part much the rain at 5 AM made sail
 saw a large branch stowed for it at 7 AM saw
 a large whale at 9 AM all boats chased and galled
 at 11 AM on board whale to the windward
 Lat by Ch. 30.03 Long in by Chs 177.12.15
 Chs Rat 5 51 1/2 show
 Wednesday January 1st the 1st 1840
 the first part weather fine whale in sight at 2 PM
 two boats and puled to the windward at 4
 PM struck and killed the ~~monster~~ Monster
 at 2 PM & got him to the ship and made fast
 for the night Mistle and later part weather fine
 employed at 5 AM began cutting at a Mer body in
 an Ijumb in row end one sail in sight Sunday Island
 in sight Lat by Ch. 29.44 Long in 177.20
 Thursday Jan 2nd Chs Rat 5 51 1/2
 the first part weather fine employed in baying
 Ceis at 2 PM spoke a ship 2000 ft N by E that
 killed 7 Months 120 barrels at 3 PM finished
 and Cleared for baying Mistle and later part
 much the rain weather with 3 from the S by E lay up E by E
 Sunday Island Lat by Ch. 29.25 Long by Chs 176.57.30
 Friday Jan 3rd Chs Rat 5 51 1/2
 the first part weather fine lay up S by West saw day island
 in sight bearing W by W Dist 40 miles at 2 PM were
 ship lay up E by E employed in baying Mistle and later
 part fresh wind clear nothing in sight saw ends employed
 in baying Lat by Ch. 29.13 Long by Chs 176.47 30
 Chs Rat 5 51 1/2 show
