the maid of the ship told one of the Boatmen Aaron Mann
two wash of clean answer of time as I still insisted otherwise
he said they were clean enough the maid took hold of him and he
climbed him and a rain on deck and had a small shindy with
him we fin this man a troublesome one and I wish he was at home
more after he ~~left~~ by the rain on board he began with my
crew the first instance was his shocking a boy on board
another he stole one of my boot covers & his bow over the board
with a stick of wood and now he goes on I have my self caught
him a sheep on deck a number of times when he has had the
watch and I have given my orders to keep a good lookout and
I have talked with him times without number and told him the
consequence of row downing but all to no purpose and so we are tired
