The first part moderate and thick and squally with rain some squalls. Much and later part much the same weather thick & squally nothing in sight by Ant

The first part squally and thick weather with moderate breeze from the off part of the compass. Much and later fine and pleasant all sail set steering W.W. by Chro

The first part weather fine all sail set saw nothing much and later part much the same at 9 AM Steamer N.W.C. saw nothing all sail set by Chro

Friday March 13th Chro Rat 5' 54" 1/2 show
The first part weather fine with strong gales from the S.E. lay up N.E. saw black fish. Much and later part much the same nothing in sight by Chro

The first part strong wind from the S.E. lay up N.E. nothing in sight much and later part much the same lay up N.E. saw nothing saw end by Chro
