Sunday May the 24 Ad 1840
the first part weather fine and pleasant on shore
at 2 AM returned on board with and later much
the rain the deserted men not yet found row end
Chro Rat & 20th slow

Monday May the 25
the first part weather fine and pleasant on watch
on shore with and later much the rain at 2 AM
found one of the Directors on board the ship
Joseph Strober by the name of Rodrick took him
on board and put him in irons row end
Chro Rat & 20th slow

Tuesday May the 26
the first part weather fine and pleasant the watch
on shore with and later much the rain at 5 PM
the Sheriff found and returned the Steward by paying
\$15.00 dollars paid the rain and took him to the ship
and put him in the irons row end

Wednesday May the 27
the first part weather fine all hands on board
waiting a wind with and later much the rain
Chro Rat & 20th slow

Thursday May the 28
the first part weather fine and pleasant with calm
with and later much the rain at 10 AM ship's
all ready for sea Chro Rat & 20th slow

Friday May the 29
the first part weather fine and pleasant with calm
later much the rain at 10 AM ship's John Bailey
now making out 24 men in all row end
Chro Rat & 20th slow

Saturday May the 30
the first part weather fine and pleasant ship waiting
a wind and one man at 4 PM ship's him
with and later much the rain row end waiting the pilot
Chro Rat & 20th slow 17.10

the first part weather fine and pleasant at 2 AM
all hands on board with and later part fine at 5 AM
the pilot came on board main sail for sea at 8 AM
the boats left off towing row end

Monday June the 1
the first part fine and pleasant the watch imple
in ship duty hour with with and later much
the rain wind ENE

Tuesday June the 2
the first part fine and pleasant all sail set
lay up North E by West with and later part
much the rain the watch imple in ship duty
Lat by Ch. 14.52 Long in 149.48 45
Chro Rat & 20th slow

Wednesday June the 3
the first part weather fine all sail set lay up NE by East
with and later much the rain lay up NE by East
saw porpoises and grampuses
Chro Rat & 20th slow

Thursday June the 4
the first part strong breeze from the SE by E lay
up NE by East with much the rain later part
lay up NE by East & North Long by Chro 148.41.15 W
Lat by Ch. 12.14
Chro Rat & 20th slow

Friday June the 5
the first part strong from the SE by E lay up NE by East
with part main muddered later part squally
with strong gails able except the topsails
Lat by Ch. 11.17 Long by Chro 148.26 15 W
Long by Dist. run time --- 148.37 45 W
Chro Rat & 20th slow
