The first part weather fine all sail set with light
breeze and calms. Mide and later noon

The first part weather fine with calms. Mide and later
part light wind from the NNE saw green por-
poises employed in setting up 2 hawsers. Chrs

The first part light wind and calms. Mide and
later part much the same saw poppers
& cowfish saw ends. By Chrs
