Sunday October the 4

The first part strong gails from West Coast
East Mill part much the rain later part more
wet with a heavy sea on at 4 AM spoke from the
ship steered down E by S saw nothing else By 4
Lat By G. 34.43 Long By G. 170.53 Rate
Long By Dist rain time 170.51 45 West

Monday Oct the 5 Gave the Choe New Rate 15.25 1/2 slow
The first part weather fine wind from the West
steering down E by S at 2 PM hauled the ship to the wind
lay up South by East at 4 PM saw 3 whales land all boats
choist could not faster saw a ship, bylling main
boat under Mill and later strong gails and squally
with a heavy sea on saw whales land struck and
drowed four ship in sight By Choe

Tuesday Oct the 6 Choe Rate 15.25 1/2
The first part weather fine all strong gails and squally
at 1 PM double reef at 3 took job and mainsail on 5
four and main top sails at 3 PM saw a right whale
two rigged to lose Milpart much the rain
later part more moderate main sail lay up & C
one ship in sight Lat By G. 34.25 Long Choe 170.17 30

Wednesday Oct the 7 Choe Rate 15.25 1/2
The first part weather fall sail set lay up & West
with light wind saw nothing mile much the
rain later part saw plenty of whales going
to the west at 5 AM land struck and parted
and for whales a number of times could not faster

The first part strong wind and squally saw
whales going quick to the Westward land choist
chood not faster Mill and later part fine

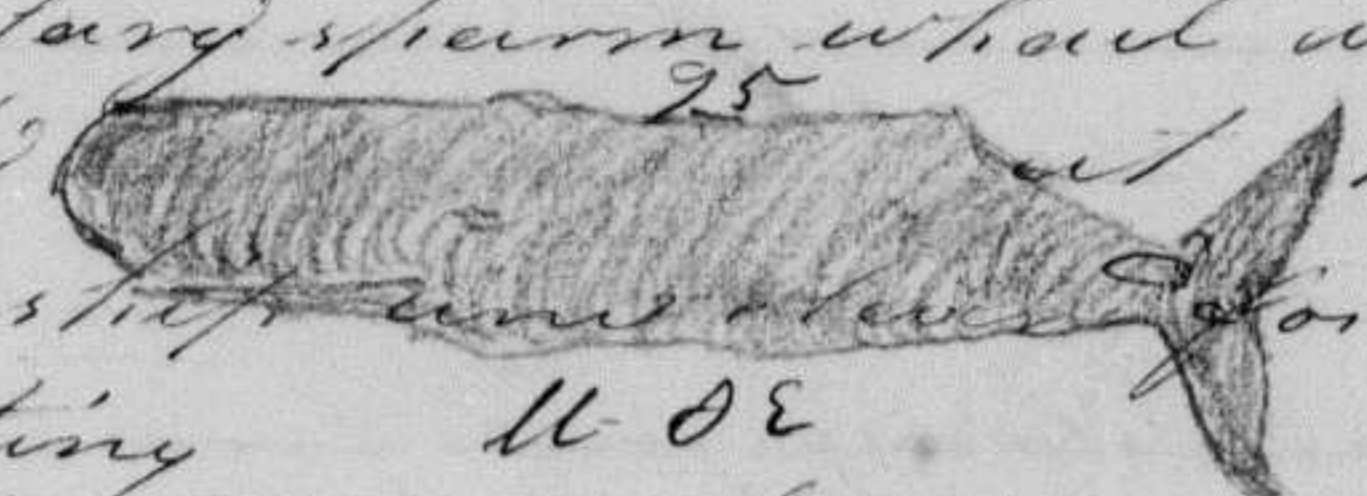
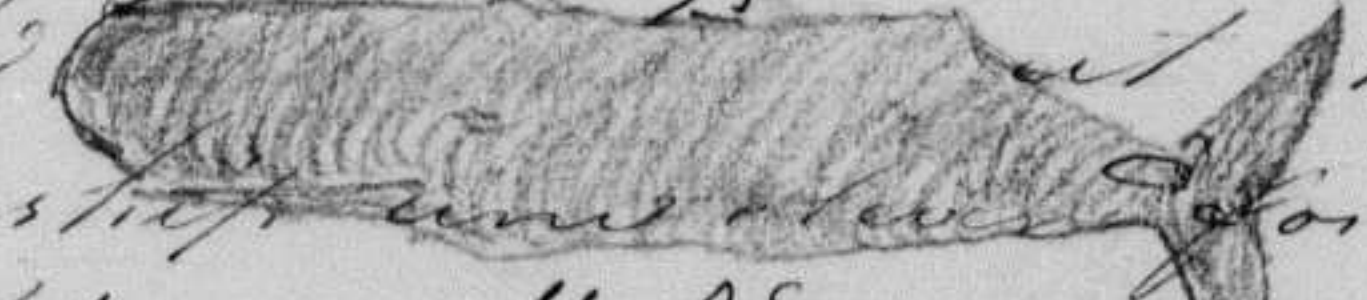
Remarks On Board Ship Martha Fair Haven

Friday October the 9 1840

The first part moderate wind from the South lay up
By S & W & West saw whales going Westward
land choist could not faster Mill and later part
much the rain saw plenty of whales land choist
at 11 AM struck and killed  saw more
whales choist did not faster  saw took
the whale to the ship plenty of whales in sight
land choist did not faster Choe

Lat By G. 34.40 Long By 170.39 30

Saturday October the 10 Choe Rate 15.25 1/2
The first part weather fine employed in cutting
at 5 PM finished cutting two ships in sight
saw one took a whale Mill and later part more
saw fin back Lat By G. 34.16 Long By Choe 171.09 30

Sunday Oct the 11 Choe Rate 15.25 1/2
The first part calm and fine weather employed in
bylling saw a ship take a whale main not more
at 8 PM finished bylling Mill and later fine
at 4 AM saw a large sperm whale at 9 land
struck and killed  at 11 AM got
the whale to the ship  for nothing
saw a ship cutting N or

Monday Oct the 12 Choe Rate 15.25 1/2
The first part weather fine all hands employed in
cutting at 8 PM finished cutting Mill and later
part much the rain weather employed in bylling
two ships in sight

Lat By G. 34.30 Long By Lat 171.00 W

Tuesday Oct the 13 Choe Rate 15.25 1/2
The first part weather fine and pleasant at 4 PM
saw right whale land struck  & killed
at 8 PM got the whale to the ship and chain on
whale rubbing back Mill and later much the rain
at 11 AM finished cutting By Lat

Lat By G. 34.49 Long 170.40
