Wednesday October the 14 1840

The first part weather fine in day in boylling and
stowing down Milt and later part much the same
weather saw whails but chait could not fasten

Thursday Oct 15 the Chro Rat 16 28 1/2

The first part weather fine saw whails going quick
to the right Milt part squawley later part strong
winds from the SE in play in stowing down at 4 PM
finished boylling saw whails going Westward

Friday Oct 16 the Chro Rat 16 28 1/2

The first part strong winds from the SE in play and
stowing down Milt and later fine all sail set saw
nothing in play in stowing down Chro

The first part weather fine all sail set saw nothing
in play in stowing down Milt and later part
strong gails and rugges saw nothing stowing SE

The first part strong gails from the WSW over H.C.
at 3 PM hauled to the wind at half past five saw
a number of right whails to take to lower

The first part weather fine with strong winds
at 4 PM saw plenty of whails fore stretch
and hild at 6 PM got the whail to the ship
I main part Milt and later fine at 10 PM
finished cutting saw whails

Wednesday Oct 21 the Chro Rat 16 29 1/2

The first part weather fine with a heavy swell on
at 1 PM saw whails out stretch and
hild at 6 PM finished cutting with bark
Cora of New Bedford 14 Masts 1100 Milt and later strong
winds and rugges in play in boylling saw whails

Long by Dist run 140 18 30

Thursday Oct 22 the Chro Rat 16 29 1/2

The first part strong winds and rugges in play in boylling
at 3 PM under ship lay up Chy J. E. S. Milt and
later part carrier in play in boylling and stowing down

Friday Oct 23 the Chro Rat 16 30

The first part light winds and rugges saw plenty
of whails but whail did not strike in play in boylling
at 6 PM finished Milt and later part much the same
at 6 AM saw whails fore stretch and hild three

at 10 got them long side and
beared for cutting saw and
