Thursday November the 5 1840

The first part strong wind from the westward saw
two struck and drove whails very dry Mistle and
later more fire saw whails and about three ships
in sight at 11 AM were to the NW

Friday November the 6 Chs Rat 15 32 1/2 slow

The first part fire with a heavy swell on at 8 PM
two for whails struck and killed at 3 PM
took the whail to the and cleared for nothing
at 4 PM finished cutting Mistle and later part
strong gails and roged later part heavy squalls
with rain lay up NW

The first part heavy gails from the West lay up. NW
with rain at 3 PM could down the works Mistle part

The first part strong wind from the westward two
sail in sight more moderate Mistle and later
moderate wind from the WSW lay up South
in play in towing down saw few whails growing
quick and about did not fasten

The first part weather fire saw finches Mistle from
the Westward with light breeze saw three ships
more moderate Mistle and later part
much the rain saw plenty of carkers

Thursday November the 12 Chs Rat 15 34 slow

The first part weather fire all sail set saw nothing
employed in setting up. spoke and cleaning down
& Repairing Boats Mistle and later much the rain
saw carkers but no whails saw three ships. one
cutting steering down W & W

Friday November the 13 Chs Rat 15 34 1/2

The first part weather fire and pleasant all
sail set saw nothing Mistle and later part much
the rain saw whails and about could not fasten

The first part weather fire and pleasant saw whails
growing to Eastward and about whails they at 8 PM
spoke ship Canverse Landers 1700 no sparm
Mistle and later much the rain saw nothing
steered to the South saw plenty of finches
