Tuesday Dec the 15 Orig Rat 18 40 1/2 slow The first part weather fine and pleasant with fine wind from the N.E. at 1 PM steered for the Bay of Island Old West Course Mist and later part much the same at 12 Mer maid Cap. Brin bearing per Compass S.E. Dist 27 Miles saw a Brig to West

Lat By G. 34.31 Long at 2 PM Chro 174 44 E Long By Dist at 8 AM 174.50 Long By Chro within 174.52 1/2

Chro Rat 18 40 1/2 slow

Wednesday Dec the 16 H Rat 18 40 1/2 The first part fine all sail set steering in for Cap. Brin at 8 PM lay off and on for the night Mist and later part much the same weather at 10 AM anchored in the Bay of Island 35-17 1/2

Lat By G. Chro Rat 18 41 1/2 slow

Thursday Dec the 17 The first part weather fine employed in clearing ship found right Tabor formerly of Ship. They took Mist and later part much the same weather employed in clearing ship at 6 AM went a raft of cargo on shore for other saw end.
