Monday Decemr the 21

The first part weather fine and pleasant employed in painting ship Mth and latter much the same Chrs Rnt 18 42

Tuesday Decemr the 22

The first part weather fine and pleasant the watch on shore one man directed Murdoch young Mth search but in vain Mth and latter fine Chrs Rnt 18 42 3/4

Wednesday Dec the 23

The first part weather fine and pleasant the watch on shore Mth part much the same later part discharged two men Antony Linking & Charles Mooker and paid them off in oil Chrs Rnt 18 42 3/4

Monday Dec the 28

The first part weather fine and pleasant employed in stowing weather Mth part fine George Harris the stevedore directed the ship Mth and latter part much the same search made to no effect Chrs Rnt 18 42 3/4

Tuesday Decemr the 29

The first part strong gale from the S^W and rainy employed in making all possible search for the Disordered men but to no effect Mth and latter part much the same Chrs Rnt 18 42 3/4

Wednesday Dec the 30

The first part weather thick and rainy employed in making search for the men to no effect Mth and latter part much the same nothing heard off the men Chrs Rnt 18 42 3/4

Thursday Dec the 31

The first part strong gale from the East and rainy employed in making search for the men but to no effect Mth and latter part much the same Chrs Rnt 18 43

Friday January the 1 1841

The first part weather fine employed in shipping men at 4 AM shipped Mth and latter part in which the same could not ship any more same end. this part Chrs Rnt 18 43 1/4

Saturday Jan the 2

The first part weather fine with light wind and warm employed in shipping men maid out to ship & more Mth and latter part much the same Chrs Rnt 18 43 1/4
