The first part weather thick and rainy employed in
shipping men at 4 PM finished shipping men
all hands on board at 12 Midnight William was dead
the ship sick and later part much better to no
effect Chro Rat 18 43 1/10

The first part fine and pleasant employed in searching
for the said man but to no effect with and later
part fine and pleasant ship a man ship waiting
for a wind now ends Chro Rat 18 43 1/10

Tuesday Jan 5
The first part weather fine and pleasant with
breeze with and later part much the same
not wind to beat out Chro Rat 18 44

Wednesday Jan the 6
The first part weather fine and pleasant with
breeze with and later part much the same

The first part weather fine and pleasant with
breeze with and later part much the same

the same weather now ends this 24 hours

Wednesday Jan the 13
The first part strong gale from the S.E. ship
all ready for sea with and later fine wind from
S.E. at 9 AM Main sail took the anchor and first to sea
now ends Chro Rat 18 45 1/10

Thursday January the 14
The first part weather fine and pleasant with moderate
breeze from the N.E. all sail set beating out the
Bay of Islands at 4 PM Capt. has been per compass
S.W. Distant Miles now ends this part with and later
part weather fine lay up N.E. Chro Rat 18 45 1/10
Lat by H. 34. 08 2

Friday January the 15
The first part light wind from the S.E. all sail
set lay up N.E. by 2 with and later part much the same
weather now ends Lat by H. 33. 41 Long by Chro 176. 20
Chro Rat 18 45

Saturday Jan the 16
The first part weather fine and pleasant all sail
set wind S.E. lay up N.E. by 4 at 4 PM tacked ship
lay up South with and later part much the same
Lat by H. 34. 06 Long by Chro 176. 19 2
Chro Rat 18 45 1/10

Sunday Jan the 17
The first part weather fine with light wind from
the S.E. all sail set N.E. by 4 with and later much
the same 7 AM the wind hauled to the south tacked
ship lay up S by 2 now ends by Chro
Lat by H. 34. 18 Long 176. 40 2
