

Remarks on Board Ship Martha F. Haven
Sunday Feb 9th 1841

The first part weather thick with moderate wind from the NW West lay up. W by S all sail set with light breeze. The rain later part strong wind with overcast lay up. W by S saw fin backs & Bluefish land got them

Friday, February 10th Chro Rat 20' 58" slow
Wednesday Feb 10th

The first part fin backs from the NW lay up. WNW all sail set at 4 PM a heavy swell from the West with light breeze. Later heavy gale from the West at 4 AM took in the fore sail and lost except the Main top sail with a heavy sea on at 5 PM under ship lay up. W West & NW by W with hail. Lat by Alt. 47.40 Long 177 East

Thursday Feb 11th Chro Rat 20' 58 1/2 slow
The first heavy gale from the S by W lay up. W by W at 2 PM took in Main top sail at 5 PM took in the fore sail with heavy squalls and hail with and later part much the same at 4 AM under moderate set M D sail and Four Spencer laying up. North Wind WNW West & Lat by Alt. 46.41 Long by Chro 176 44.15

Friday Feb 12th Chro Rat 20' 58 1/2 slow
The first part heavy gale from the S West with rain with and later part much the same at 4 AM steamed down E & W saw nothing by Chro at 3 PM Lat by Alt. 46.24 Long 177.25 45 E Long by Dist at 8 AM 177.96 Long by Chro Sun time 176.37 Lat 28 miles Chro Rat 20' 58 1/2 slow

Saturday Feb 13th
The first part strong gale from the West down N by E saw nothing with and later part light wind saw fin backs saw and Lat by Alt. 45.42 Long at 8 AM 179.08 E Lat Sun time by Dist 179.22 Chro Rat 20' 58 1/2 slow

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Sunday February the 14 1841

The first part strong wind from the NW W down N by E imp. lay in bending New four sail & Main top sail with light wind. Later part strong 4 AM wind bound to the NW with strong gale saw and saw fin backs at 3 PM Lat by Alt. 44.54 Long by Chro 177 55 15

Monday February the 15 Chro Rat 20' 58" slow
Long by Dist at 8.30 178.54 W Sun time Chro 178.43 15
The first part weather clear with strong wind from the West down N by E at 3 PM spoke ship. Corinthian of Bristol 12.00 bound to the Chatham Mill and later moderate all sail set down E by W at 10 AM main the land ahead saw and saw nothing but land and cold weather by Chro

Tuesday Feb 16th Chro Rat 20' 58 1/2 slow
Long by Alt. 44.12 Long 177 12 45 W
The first part strong wind from the S by W lay up. E & E at 4 PM the Porcupine lower per compass E & E Dist 25 miles double reef the four & Main top sail and I kept the in our Mill and later part rain and light wind the Porcupine bearing E & E Dist 15 miles Dist pits island bearing W & E Dist 18 miles Chro

Wednesday Feb 17th Chro Rat 20' 58 1/2 slow
Lat by Alt. 44.21 Long by 176.30 West
The first part moderate and warm Porcupine bearing W & E Dist 7 miles with and later strong wind and thick at 10 AM steamed E by North saw nothing by Chro

Thursday Feb 18th Chro Rat 20' 58 1/2 slow
Lat by Alt. 44.35 Long 175.00 West
The first part strong wind from the NW Steady E by N at 5 PM saw bluefish held four with and later fin saw bluefish held four imp. lay in clearing them Lat by Alt. 44.35 Long by Chro 174.21 W Chro Rat 20' 58 1/2 slow
