in Chair saw end. Lat by Oct 44.15 174.49

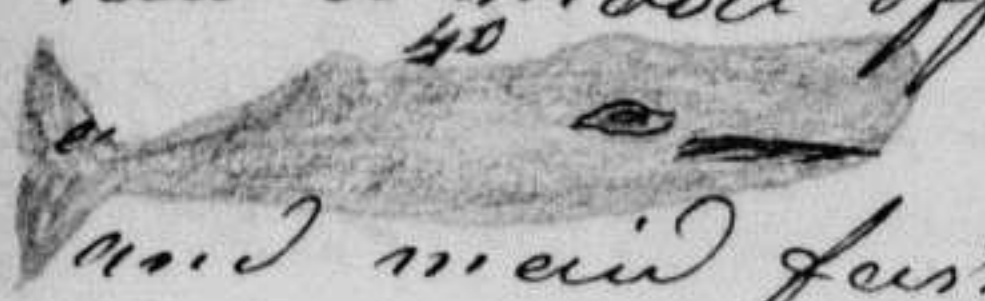

The first part midwest wind and fine imployed in
stowing down at 5 PM finished saw nothing with
part much the same later part midwest at 6 AM

saw a school off whails tow the windward 3 miles distant
hauled in WNW at 9 AM Mous ship lay up for the
whails with fresh gails and thick weather at 10 AM

lost the run off the whails weather thick with
strong gails took in M.T. Sail. M. Sail and
Jable Breeft saw nothing more
