Tuesday March 2<sup>nd</sup> 1841

The first part strong wind and squally lay up 2<sup>nd</sup> by 6 mile and later part more moderate at 4 PM saw black fish. Lord got one

Lat by Aut 42.00 Long by Aut 155.10 W

Wednesday March 3<sup>rd</sup> Chro Rat 21 01 1/2 slow  
The first part moderate wind from the Eastward lay up 2<sup>nd</sup> at 8 PM tacked ship lay up 2<sup>nd</sup> mile and later part moderate lay up 2<sup>nd</sup> mile

Lat by Ch 42.15 Long by Aut 155.00 W

Thursday March 4<sup>th</sup> Chro Rat 21 01 1/2  
The first part rather some thick with light winds and carries Mist and later part Moderate breezes from the North Cove East

Lat by Ch 42.32 Long by Chro 155.38 15 W

Friday March 5<sup>th</sup> Chro Rat 21 01 1/2 slow  
The first part moderate wind and thick Cove East wind NW Mist and later part with fine wind from the NW West saw nothing

Lat by Ch 42.38 Long by Chro 154.28 30 W

Saturday March 6<sup>th</sup> Chro Rat 21 01 1/2 slow  
The first part moderate wind from the NW Cove East by 8 mile and later part much the same weather saw nothing saw end

Lat by Ch 42.45 Long by Aut 151.50 West

Sunday March 7<sup>th</sup> Chro Rat 21 02  
The first part light wind from the NW Cove East by 8 mile and later part much the same

Lat by Ch 42.48 Long by Chro 150.55 W

Monday March 8<sup>th</sup> Chro Rat 21 02 1/2 slow  
The first part light wind and carries Mist part much the same later part fine wind from NW West Cove East

Lat by Ch 43.01 Long 159.26 W

Tuesday March 9<sup>th</sup> Chro Rat 21 02 1/2  
The first part light wind from the NW West Cove East by 8 mile and later part strong gale from the NW West Cove East at 8 PM took in 2<sup>nd</sup> of 2<sup>nd</sup> sail Lat by Ch 42.54 2<sup>nd</sup> Long by Chro 156.48 30 Chro Rat 21 02 1/2 slow

Wednesday March 10<sup>th</sup> 1841

The first part strong gale from the South Cove East with a heavy sea on Mist and later part more Moderate turned out the reefs out 2<sup>nd</sup> of 2<sup>nd</sup> sail at 11 AM squally part one reef in Main 2<sup>nd</sup> sail

Lat by Ch 42.24 Long by Chro 153.44

Thursday March 11<sup>th</sup> Chro Rat 21 02 1/2 slow  
The first part strong gale from the South West part Moderate later part strong at 4 PM the wind bound to the West Cove East made all sail No Obs

Lat by Aut 42.20 Long by Aut 150.00 West

Friday March 12<sup>th</sup> Chro Rat 21 03 slow  
The first part strong wind from the West mile part more moderate later part fine all sail set Cove East wind WSW saw nothing

Lat by Ch 42.22 Long by Chro 147.30 45

Saturday March 13<sup>th</sup> Chro Rat 21 03 1/2 slow  
The first part fresh wind from the WSW all sail set Cove Mist part more light light later part much the same

Lat by Ch 43.03 Long by 144.16 45 W

Sunday March 14<sup>th</sup> Chro Rat 21 03 1/2  
The first part fine wind from the West all sail set Cove by 8 mile and later part much the same at 8 PM got a Dist. and made the Longitude 142.39.15 W

Lat by Ch 43.33 Long by Chro at 8 PM 142.40

Monday March 15<sup>th</sup> Chro Rat 21 03 1/2  
The first part fine and pleasant with fine breezes from the NW Mist and later part moderate & carries at 8 PM got a Dist. and made the Longitude 140.09 West

Lat by Ch 43.56 Long by Chro 140.20 West

Tuesday March 16<sup>th</sup> Chro Rat 21 03 1/2 slow  
The first part light wind and carries Mist part much the same later part Moderate from the North lay up East weather thick

Lat by Aut 43.47 Long by Aut 139.35

Chro Rat 21 04 slow
