and steady with no squalls Chro

the first part fine wind from the W West Coast
E by S all sail set Mile and later part thick
with fine wind from the W West Coast E by S
No Ch Lat by Alt 54.42 Long by 88.57

saw a ship heading to the W West main not
near saw end No Ch this day Coast E by S

Saturday April 10th 1841

Chro Rat 21 07 show
the first part strong gale from the West Coast E by S
all sail set weather thick with some rain Mile and
later part much the same Lat by the Moon at 2 PM
57.30 No Ch by the sun Long by Ch 68.30

the first part strong wind from the West Coast
E by S Mile and later part moderate at 3 AM
wind hauled to the North with moderate breezes

Monday April 12th 1841
Lat by Alt 57.12 Long by 62.31.15 W
Chro Rat 21 07 show
the first part moderate wind from the W West
lay up S by N at 3 PM wind hauled to the S West
steered N by E Mile and later moderate from the
North lay up S by E at 12 Mer went off our ship
lay up N by W with thick by Alt

Tuesday April 13th 1841
Lat by Alt 56.40 Long by 58.28
Chro Rat 21 07 show
the first part strong gale from the North lay up N West by W
saw a big Mile and later part moderate lay up North
Coast Lat by Alt 56.40 Long by 58.28
Chro Rat 21 07 show rain thick by Dist 58.30
