the first part heavy gails from the South down
N by E under short sail with a heavy sea on

N by E all sail set with and later part moderate
nothing in sight employed in fitting rigging

Wednesday May 5th Chro Rate 23 13 1/2 show
the first part moderate wind from the NW West
all sail set lay up N West with and later
more favorable lay up N by E at 9 AM squally
at 10 took in top of sails and single reef
N by E

Thursday May 6th Chro Rate 23 14 1/2 show
the first part strong gails and squally wind from
the NW West down North lay up N by E with part heavy
gails later part more moderate from the NW West
down North

Friday May 7th
the first part moderate wind from the South with
and later part calms and fine weather saw
fine birds were seen
