 The first part movement from the NW by lay up
 NW by N & NW W while and later fine breeze
 from the N by E lower NW by N

 Tuesday June 29th Chro Rate 27.24¹⁰ slow
 The first part movement wind from the N by E
 lower NW West all sail set midle and later
 much the rain saw end

 NW by N all sail set saw one ship on back

 Thursday July 1st Chro Rate 27.25¹⁰ slow
 The first part light wind from the West
 lower NW West midle and later part much
 the rain at 4 AM spew a Spanish Brig 20 days
 from Havannah bound to Bonabona
 Lat by Ch. 33.39 Long by Chro 39.15.15 W
 Friday July 2nd Chro Rate 27.25¹⁰ slow
 The first part fine wind from the N by W lower
 NW West all sail set while part much
 the rain later part some squally with
 rain and thunder & lightning Chro
 Lat by Ch. 35.13 Long by 40.05.15 W
 Chro Rate 27.25¹⁰ slow

 Saturday July 3rd 1841
 The first part strong wind from the
 West lower NW West at 6 PM steared NW by N
 all sail set midle and later strong wind
 at 9 AM squally with rain Chro
 Lat by Ch. 37.29 Long by 40.43.30
 Sunday July 4th Chro Rate 27.25¹⁰ slow
 The first part with fine with fine wind from the
 West at 4 PM wind from the NW West lay up NW by N
 at 5 PM tacked ship lay up NW W while part
 lay up NW by N later part lay up NW West with
 light wind from the N East one sail tow the line
 Lat by Ch. 38.07 Long by Chro 41.43.30
 Monday July 5th Chro Rate 27.28¹⁰ slow
 The first part movement from the N by E lay
 up NW W while part much the rain at 2 AM
 tacked ship lay up NW by N later strong wind
 lay up NW by N at 4 AM tacked lay up NW by N
 Lat by Ch. 38.42 Long by Chro 42.15.45
 Tuesday July 6th Chro Rate 27.28¹⁰ slow
 The first part light wind from the NW West lay
 West at 8 AM took a wind from the S by W lower
